## Associations of "Blankly" (30 Words)

<a href="#">amaze</a>	Affect with wonder. <i>He has been <b>amazed</b> by the quality of the employees at the bank.</i>
<b>astonish</b>	Surprise or impress (someone) greatly. <i>It <b>astonished</b> her that he was so anxious.</i>
<b>astound</b>	Affect with wonder. <i>Her bluntness <b>astounded</b> him.</i>
<a href="#">bare</a>	Just barely adequate or within a lower limit. <i>An ordeal that would lay <b>bare</b> a troubled family background.</i>
<b>bathtub</b>	A bath.
<b>bemuse</b>	Puzzle, confuse, or bewilder (someone). <i>He was <b>bemused</b> by what was happening.</i>
<a href="#">bewilder</a>	Be a mystery or bewildering to. <i>His reaction had <b>bewildered</b> her.</i>
<b>clean</b>	Be cleanable. <i>Led a <b>clean</b> life.</i>
<a href="#">daze</a>	Overcome as with astonishment or disbelief. <i>His mother's death left him in a <b>daze</b>.</i>
<a href="#">empty</a>	Leave behind empty move out of. <i>An <b>empty</b> room.</i>
<b>famish</b>	Be hungry; go without food. <i>They had <b>famished</b> the city into surrender.</i>
<a href="#">immaculate</a>	(in the Roman Catholic Church) free from sin. <i>The apartment was <b>immaculate</b>.</i>
<b>impassive</b>	Deliberately impassive in manner. <i>He remained <b>impassive</b> showing neither interest in nor concern for our plight.</i>

<b>lave</b>	Wash one's face and hands. <i>The waves <b>laved</b> the shore.</i>
<b><u>pristine</u></b>	Immaculately clean and unused. <i><b>Pristine</b> mountain snow.</i>
<b><u>spotless</u></b>	Completely neat and clean. <i>A <b>spotless</b> white apron.</i>
<b>stun</b>	Overcome as with astonishment or disbelief. <i>The news <b>stunned</b> her.</i>
<b>stupefy</b>	Astonish and shock. <i>The offence of administering drugs to a woman with intent to <b>stupefy</b> her.</i>
<b><u>stupor</u></b>	Marginal consciousness. <i>Someone stole his wallet while he was in a drunken <b>stupor</b>.</i>
<b>surprise</b>	Cause to be surprised. <i>The announcement came as a complete <b>surprise</b>.</i>
<b>surprised</b>	Taken unawares or suddenly and feeling wonder or astonishment. <i>A <b>surprised</b> expression.</i>
<b><u>tidy</u></b>	Of hair neat and tidy. <i>His scrupulously <b>tidy</b> apartment.</i>
<b>uncontaminated</b>	Not contaminated. <i><b>Uncontaminated</b> air and food.</i>
<b>unoccupied</b>	(of a building, seat, etc.) not being occupied or used. <i><b>Unoccupied</b> France.</i>
<b>unpainted</b>	Not having a coat of paint or badly in need of a fresh coat. <i><b>Unpainted</b> furniture.</i>
<b>unpolluted</b>	Not defiled or corrupted. <i><b>Unpolluted</b> streams.</i>
<b>unspotted</b>	Not marked with spots. <i>It has an <b>unspotted</b> white throat.</i>
<b>unstained</b>	Free from blemishes. <i>An apron keeps his clothing <b>unstained</b>.</i>
<b>unsullied</b>	(of reputation) free from blemishes. <i>An <b>unsullied</b> reputation.</i>
<b>vacancy</b>	Lack of intelligence or understanding. <i>A <b>vacancy</b> for a shorthand typist.</i>
