Associations of "Blend in" (30 Words)

alloy	Make an alloy of. <i>An alloy of nickel bronze and zinc.</i>
amalgam	An alloy of mercury with another metal usually silver used by dentists to fill cavities in teeth except for iron and platinum all metals dissolve in mercury and chemists refer to the resulting mercury mixtures as amalgams. <i>Amalgam fillings.</i>
amalgamate	Alloy (a metal) with mercury. <i>Numerous small British railway companies amalgamated.</i>
blended	Combined or mixed together so that the constituent parts are indistinguishable.
blending	The act of blending components together thoroughly. <i>Clever cultural blendings.</i>
coalesce	Combine (elements) in a mass or whole. <i>The puddles had coalesced into shallow streams.</i>
combination	A sequence of numbers or letters used to open a combination lock. <i>Woollen combinations.</i>
composite	A composite constructional material. <i>This soup is one of those composite dishes which you gradually build up.</i>
compound	Composed of more than one partcompound flower heads. <i>A blackberry is a compound fruit.</i>
conflate	Combine (two or more sets of information, texts, ideas, etc.) into one. <i>The urban crisis conflates a number of different economic political and social issues.</i>
eclectic	Someone who selects according to the eclectic method. <i>Universities offering an eclectic mix of courses.</i>
filling	The act of filling something. <i>Duvets with synthetic fillings.</i>

fusible	Capable of being melted and fused.
harmonious	Existing together in harmony. <i>The tailored clothes were harmonious with her military bearing.</i>
indoors	Into or within a building. <i>They went indoors and explored the house.</i>
inner	Innermost or essential. <i>The Doctor found the bull and held it to the close while Servis only scored inners.</i>
integrate	Become one become integrated. <i>A fully equipped laboratory is being integrated into the development.</i>
interior	Relating to a country's internal affairs. <i>Interior scenes.</i>
intermingle	Combine into one. <i>We don t intermingle much.</i>
interweave	Blend closely. <i>The branches met and interwove above his head.</i>
inwardly	With respect to private feelings. <i>Inwardly seething he did as he was told.</i>
lead	An artificial watercourse leading to a mill. <i>It was a tangle of jumper cables and clip leads.</i>
<u>meld</u>	A thing formed by melding a combination. <i>Australia s winemakers have melded modern science with traditional art.</i>
<u>mingle</u>	Be all mixed up or jumbled together. <i>A smell which mingled disinfectant and soap.</i>
mix	Mix together different elements. <i>Peppercorns are sometimes mixed with other spices.</i>
<u>mixture</u>	An event that combines things in a mixture. <i>Form the mixture into a manageable dough.</i>
roan	A roan animal. <i>A roan horse.</i>
<u>shuffle</u>	A change of order or relative positions a reshuffle. <i>She shuffled her papers into a neat pile.</i>
unite	Act in concert or unite in a common purpose or belief. <i>His work unites theory and practice.</i>
weld	Forge an article by welding. <i>Steel plates were being welded.</i>
