Bloated as an Adjective

Definitions of "Bloated" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “bloated” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *(of a person) excessively wealthy and pampered.*
- *Swollen with fluid or gas.*
- *Excessive in size or amount.*



Synonyms of "Bloated" as an adjective (8 Words)

- bulging** Curving or bulging outward.
*My **bulging** suitcase is sitting by the door.*
- distended** Swollen due to pressure from inside; bloated.
*A **distended** belly.*
- enlarged** Of an organ or body part excessively enlarged as a result of increased size in the constituent cells.
*An **enlarged** spleen.*
- expanded** Increased in extent or size or bulk or scope.
***Expanded** polystyrene.*
- inflated** Enlarged beyond truth or reasonableness.
***Inflated** salaries.*

puffed out Gathered for protruding fullness.

puffed up Gathered for protruding fullness.

swollen Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.
*Growing ever more **swollen** headed and arbitrary.*



Usage Examples of "Bloated" as an adjective

- *He had a bloated, unshaven face.*
- *The company trimmed its bloated labour force.*
- *The bloated captains of industry.*
