Bloated as an Adjective

Definitions of "Bloated" as an adjective

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "bloated" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- (of a person) excessively wealthy and pampered.
- Swollen with fluid or gas.
- Excessive in size or amount.





Synonyms of "Bloated" as an adjective (8 Words)

<u>bulging</u>	Curving or bulging outward. My bulging suitcase is sitting by the door.
distended	Swollen due to pressure from inside; bloated. A distended belly.
enlarged	Of an organ or body part excessively enlarged as a result of increased size in the constituent cells. <i>An enlarged spleen.</i>
expanded	Increased in extent or size or bulk or scope. <i>Expanded</i> polystyrene.
<u>inflated</u>	Enlarged beyond truth or reasonableness. <i>Inflated</i> salaries.



puffed out Gathered for protruding fullness.

puffed up Gathered for protruding fullness.

swollen Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance. *Growing ever more swollen headed and arbitrary.*



Usage Examples of "Bloated" as an adjective

- He had a bloated, unshaven face.
- The company trimmed its bloated labour force.
- The bloated captains of industry.
