Synonyms of "Bloke" as a noun (13 Words)

blighter	A boy or man. <i>You little blighter.</i>
body	A resonating chamber in a musical instrument as the body of a violin. <i>They found his body washed up on the beach.</i>
boy	A youthful male person. <i>A four year old boy.</i>
chap	A crack in a lip caused usually by cold. <i>That chap is your host.</i>
cuss	A persistently annoying person. <i>He was certainly an unsociable cuss.</i>
fella	A boy or man. <i>She took a fancy to her best friend s fella.</i>

feller	A person who fells trees.
fellow	A member of a learned society. <i>He sent e mail to his fellow hackers.</i>
gent	Informal abbreviation of gentleman. <i>A gents hairdressing shop.</i>
individual	A single organism. <i>Boat trips for parties and individuals.</i>
lad	A stable worker (regardless of age or sex). <i>It s great for the lads that the horse has won the National.</i>
male	An animal that produces gametes spermatozoa that can fertilize female gametes ova. <i>The audience consisted of adult males.</i>
man	An adult person who is male as opposed to a woman. <i>Cro Magnon man.</i>
