Synonyms of "Bloodbath" as a noun (7 Words)

battue	The driving of game towards hunters by beaters. <i>They were shot down like pheasants in a battue.</i>
bloodletting	The surgical removal of some of a patient's blood for therapeutic purposes. <i>Gang members have halted their internecine bloodletting.</i>
bloodshed	The killing or wounding of people, typically on a large scale during a conflict. <i>The president feared bloodshed and disorder if the demands for reform were not met.</i>
mass slaughter	The property of something that is great in magnitude.
slaughter	The killing of animals (as for food). <i>Thousands of calves were exported to the continent for slaughter.</i>
wholesale killing	The selling of goods to merchants; usually in large quantities for resale to consumers.
wholesale slaughter	The selling of goods to merchants; usually in large quantities for resale to consumers.



Usage Examples of "Bloodbath" as a noun

- *A bloodbath took place when the leaders of the plot surrendered.*
- *He allowed the protest to go ahead despite warnings that it would spark a bloodbath.*
