Associations of "Bloodied" (30 Words)

barbarism	A brutal barbarous savage act. <i>The collapse of civilization and the return to barbarism.</i>
bloodthirsty	Marked by eagerness to resort to violence and bloodshed. <i>A bloodthirsty occult movie.</i>
brutal	Punishingly harsh. <i>A brutal winter.</i>
brutish	Resembling or characteristic of a brute. <i>A dull and brutish man.</i>
carnage	The savage and excessive killing of many people. <i>The bombing was timed to cause as much carnage as possible.</i>
counterattack	Make a counterattack.
cruel	Causing pain or suffering. <i>Cruel tortures.</i>
ferocious	Very great; extreme. <i>A ferocious beast.</i>
ferocity	The state or quality of being ferocious. <i>The ferocity of the storm caught them by surprise.</i>
fierce	(of a mechanism) having a jolting and powerful abruptness of action. <i>Fierce fighting continued throughout the day.</i>
fighting	The action of fighting violence or conflict. <i>He was a fighting man.</i>
flaming	Very hot. <i>Where s that flaming taxi.</i>
gory	Covered with blood. <i>A gory dagger.</i>
heinous	Extremely wicked, deeply criminal. <i>A battery of heinous crimes.</i>

hemorrhage	Lose blood from one's body.
inhuman	Without compunction or human feeling. <i>A babel of inhuman noises.</i>
inhumane	Without compassion for misery or suffering; cruel. <i>Confining wild horses is inhumane.</i>
internecine	Characterized by bloodshed and carnage for both sides. <i>Internecine war.</i>
pitiless	(especially of weather) unrelentingly harsh or severe. <i>A night of pitiless rain.</i>
rampage	Violently angry and destructive behavior. <i>Youths went on the rampage and wrecked a classroom.</i>
repression	The action of subduing someone or something by force. <i>His goal was the repression of insolence.</i>
ruthless	Without mercy or pity. <i>A ruthless manipulator.</i>
sadistic	Deriving pleasure or sexual gratification from inflicting pain on another. <i>A sadistic killer.</i>
sanguinary	Accompanied by bloodshed. <i>This bitter and sanguinary war.</i>
savage	(of a place) wild-looking and inhospitable; uncultivated. <i>Packs of savage dogs roamed the streets.</i>
shambles	A butcher's slaughterhouse (archaic except in place names). <i>My career was in a shambles.</i>
truculence	Obstreperous and defiant aggressiveness.
tussle	Make messy or untidy. <i>The demonstrators tussled with police.</i>
violent	Marked by extreme intensity of emotions or convictions inclined to react violently fervid. <i>A violent rage.</i>
warmonger	A person who advocates war or warlike policies.
