Synonyms of "Bloodthirsty" as an adjective (9 Words)

bellicose	Having or showing a ready disposition to fight. <i>Bellicose</i> young officers.
bloody-minded	Stubbornly obstructive and unwilling to cooperate- Spectator.
homicidal	Characteristic of or capable of or having a tendency toward killing another human being. A homicidal rage.
<u>murderous</u>	Extremely arduous or unpleasant. The most vicious and murderous acts of human aggression.
sadistic	Deriving pleasure or sexual gratification from inflicting pain on another. She took a sadistic pleasure in tormenting him.
sanguinary	Marked by eagerness to resort to violence and bloodshed. They lost heavily in the sanguinary campaigns that followed.



violent	Marked by extreme intensity of emotions or convictions inclined to react violently fervid. <i>A violent attack.</i>
<u>warlike</u>	(of plans, preparations, or munitions) directed towards or prepared for war. Warlike preparations could be made quickly.








Usage Examples of "Bloodthirsty" as an adjective

Associations of "Bloodthirsty" (30 Words)

<u>atrocity</u>	A highly unpleasant or distasteful object. A textbook which detailed war atrocities.
barbarism	Extreme cruelty or brutality. She called the execution an act of barbarism .
brutal	Punishingly harsh. The brutal summer sun.
brutish	Resembling or characteristic of a brute. A dull and brutish man.
cruel	Spoil or ruin (an opportunity or a chance of success. <i>Cruel</i> tortures.
devilry	Wicked activity. Some spirit of devilry made me go on teasing her.
<u>ferocious</u>	Marked by extreme and violent energy. A ferocious beating.
<u>ferocity</u>	The state or quality of being ferocious. She hated him with a ferocity that astonished her.
<u>gory</u>	Covered in blood. A gory dagger.
<u>heinous</u>	Extremely wicked, deeply criminal. <i>Heinous</i> accusations.
<u>horror</u>	A thing causing a feeling of horror. Photographs showed the horror of the tragedy.
inhuman	Without compunction or human feeling. Something dark and inhuman in form.
inhumane	Without compassion for misery or suffering; cruel. Humans are innately inhumane this explains much of the misery and suffering in the world.
internecine	Relating to conflict within a group. The region s history of savage internecine warfare.
<u>merciless</u>	Having or showing no mercy. Gave him a merciless beating.
oppression	Mental pressure or distress. The tyrant s oppression of the people.
pitiless	(especially of weather) unrelentingly harsh or severe. A night of pitiless rain.



<u>rampage</u>	A period of violent and uncontrollable behaviour by a group of people. Several thousand demonstrators rampage d through the city.
<u>repression</u>	The restraint, prevention, or inhibition of a feeling, quality, etc. <i>The long repression of Christian sects.</i>
<u>ruthless</u>	Without mercy or pity. A ruthless manipulator.
ruthlessness	Feelings of extreme heartlessness. The real world ruthlessness of business.
sanguinary	Marked by eagerness to resort to violence and bloodshed. Went after the collaborators with a sanguinary fury that drenched the land with blood.
savage	Attack brutally and fiercely. The mother of one of the victims has described his assailants as savage s.
shambles	A building where animals are butchered. The shambles where the animals were slaughtered.
<u>tyrant</u>	A tyrant flycatcher. <i>His father was a tyrant.</i>
vampire	(in European folklore) a corpse supposed to leave its grave at night to drink the blood of the living by biting their necks with long pointed canine teeth. <i>The protectionist</i> vampire s in the Congress.
warmonger	A person who advocates war or warlike policies.
warmth	Intensity of emotion. She smiled with real warmth .
