## Synonyms of "Blubber" as a noun (6 Words)

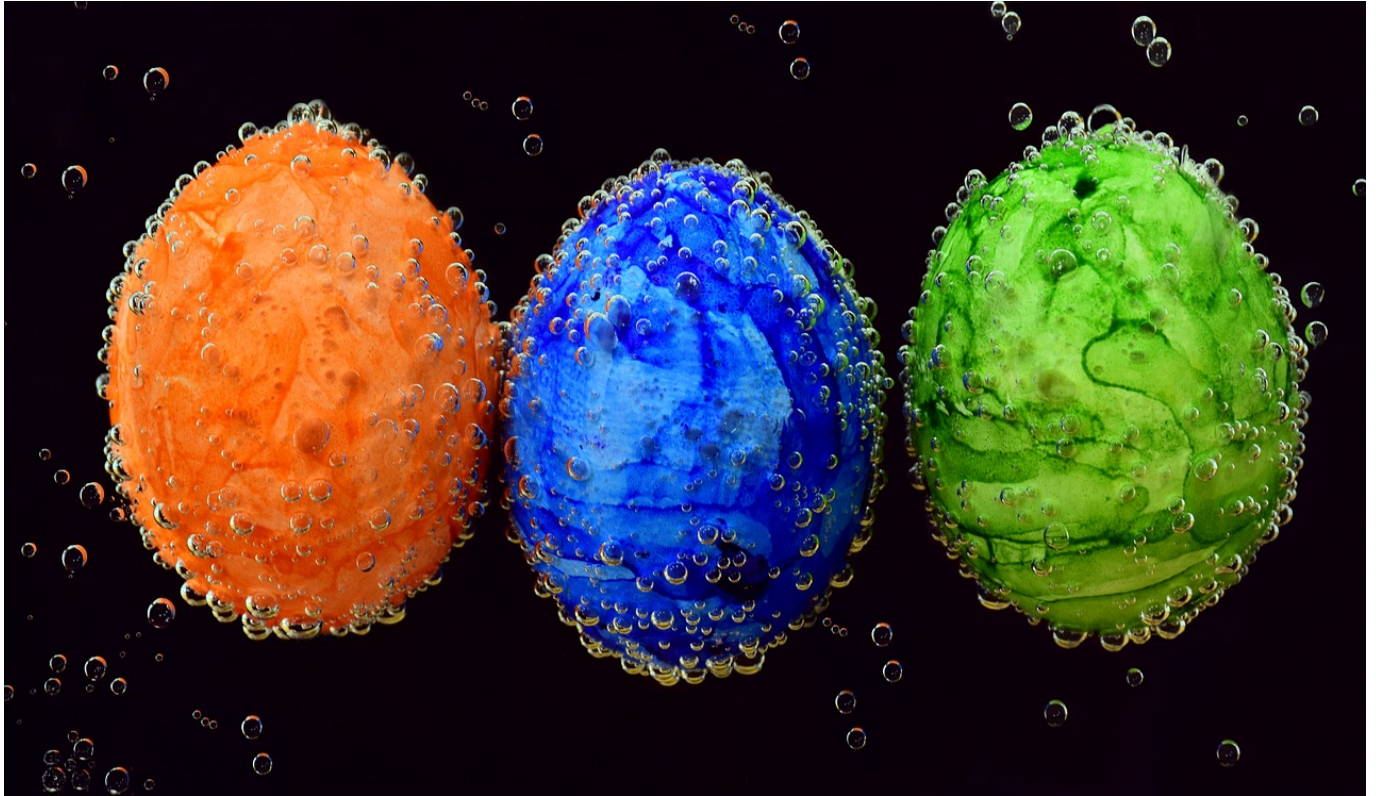
- avoirdupois** A system of weights based on the 16-ounce pound (or 7,000 grains.

- bulk** The greater part of something.

- fat** A kind of body tissue containing stored fat that serves as a source of energy it also cushions and insulates vital organs.  
*She disliked **fatness** in herself as well as in others.*
- fatness** A soft greasy substance occurring in organic tissue and consisting of a mixture of lipids (mostly triglycerides).  
*She disliked **fatness** in herself as well as in others.*
- fatty tissue** A rotund individual.
- plumpness** The quality of having a full rounded shape.  
*She grew up being teased for her **plumpness**.*

## Synonyms of "Blubber" as a verb (5 Words)

**blub** Cry or whine with snuffling.  
*She had the urge to **blub** her eyes out.*

**blubber out** Cry or whine with snuffling.

<b>sniffle</b>	Sniff slightly or repeatedly, typically because of a cold or fit of crying. <i>Claire rubbed her nose, sniffing loudly.</i>
<b>snivel</b>	Snuff up mucus through the nose. <i>Kate started to <b>snivel</b> looking sad and stunned.</i>
<b>snuffle</b>	Breathe noisily through the nose due to a cold or crying. <i>The collie <b>snuffled</b> around his boots.</i>

<b>baleen</b>	Whalebone. <i>The <b>baleen</b> plates of a Greenland right whale.</i>
<b>beef</b>	The substance of a matter. <i>Getting caught with pot in the sixties was a narco <b>beef</b>.</i>
<b>calve</b>	Give birth to (a calf). <i>Ice <b>calved</b> off a glacier with a loud explosive crumble.</i>



<b>caribou</b>	Arctic deer with large antlers in both sexes called reindeer in Eurasia and caribou in North America.
<b>cetacean</b>	Relating to or denoting cetaceans.
<b>dolphin</b>	A small gregarious toothed whale that typically has a beaklike snout and a curved fin on the back. Dolphins have become well known for their sociable nature and high intelligence.
<b>fat</b>	A fatty substance made from animal or plant products used in cooking. <i>Whales and seals insulate themselves with layers of <b>fat</b>.</i>
<b>flesh</b>	Remove the flesh adhering to a skin or hide. <i>Halve the avocados and scrape out the <b>flesh</b>.</i>
<b>fleshy</b>	(of a person or part of the body) having a substantial amount of flesh; plump. <i>Her <b>fleshy</b> arms.</i>
<b>ham</b>	Son of Noah. <i>Thin slices of <b>ham</b>.</i>
<b>juicy</b>	Having strong sexual appeal. <i>The promise of <b>juicy</b> returns.</i>
<b>meat</b>	The edible part of fruits, nuts, or eggs. <i>He did the <b>meat</b> of the climb on the first day.</i>
<b>mutton</b>	The flesh of fully grown sheep used as food. <i>A leg of <b>mutton</b>.</i>
<b>omnivorous</b>	Indiscriminate in taking in or using whatever is available. <i>An <b>omnivorous</b> reader.</i>
<b>penguin</b>	A large flightless seabird of the southern hemisphere, with black upper parts and white underparts and wings developed into flippers for swimming under water.
<b>porcine</b>	Of, affecting, or resembling a pig or pigs. <i>A bald <b>porcine</b> old man.</i>
<b>pork</b>	Meat from a domestic hog or pig. <i><b>Pork</b> chops.</i>
<b>porpoise</b>	Move through the water like a porpoise alternately rising above it and submerging. <i>The boat began to <b>porpoise</b> badly.</i>
<b>protein</b>	Proteins collectively especially as a dietary component. <i>Animal <b>proteins</b>.</i>
<b>raw</b>	Devoid of elaboration or diminution or concealment; bare and pure. <i>Received <b>raw</b> treatment from his friends.</i>

<b>salmon</b>	The flesh of the salmon as food. <i>Cotton checked throw in cream and <b>salmon</b> pink.</i>
<b>shark</b>	A small SE Asian freshwater fish with a tail resembling that of a shark popular in aquaria. <i>As soon as he arrived he was <b>sharking</b> among the women.</i>
<b>spermaceti</b>	A white waxy substance produced by the sperm whale, formerly used in candles and ointments. It is present in a rounded organ in the head, where it focuses acoustic signals and aids in the control of buoyancy.
<b>steak</b>	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. <i>A fillet <b>steak</b>.</i>
<b>succulent</b>	A succulent plant. <i><b>Succulent</b> roast beef.</i>
<b>tuna</b>	The flesh of the tuna as food.
<b>uncooked</b>	Not cooked; raw. <i>Frozen ready meals may be completely <b>uncooked</b>.</i>
<b>vegetarian</b>	Relating to vegetarians or vegetarianism. <i>A <b>vegetarian</b> restaurant.</i>
<b>whale</b>	Hunt for whales.
<b>whaler</b>	A ship engaged in whale fishing.
