caribou	Arctic deer with large antlers in both sexes called reindeer in Eurasia and caribou in North America.
cetacean	Relating to or denoting cetaceans.
dolphin	A small gregarious toothed whale that typically has a beaklike snout and a curved fin on the back. Dolphins have become well known for their sociable nature and high intelligence.
fat	A fatty substance made from animal or plant products used in cooking. Whales and seals insulate themselves with layers of fat .
<u>flesh</u>	Remove the flesh adhering to a skin or hide. Halve the avocados and scrape out the flesh .
fleshy	(of a person or part of the body) having a substantial amount of flesh; plump. <i>Her</i> fleshy <i>arms</i> .
ham	Son of Noah. Thin slices of ham .
<u>juicy</u>	Having strong sexual appeal. The promise of juicy returns.
<u>meat</u>	The edible part of fruits, nuts, or eggs. <i>He did the meat of the climb on the first day.</i>
mutton	The flesh of fully grown sheep used as food. A leg of mutton .
omnivorous	Indiscriminate in taking in or using whatever is available. An omnivorous reader.
penguin	A large flightless seabird of the southern hemisphere, with black upper parts and white underparts and wings developed into flippers for swimming under water.
porcine	Of, affecting, or resembling a pig or pigs. A bald porcine old man.
pork	Meat from a domestic hog or pig. Pork chops.
porpoise	Move through the water like a porpoise alternately rising above it and submerging. <i>The boat began to porpoise badly.</i>
protein	Proteins collectively especially as a dietary component. Animal protein s.
raw	Devoid of elaboration or diminution or concealment; bare and pure. <i>Received raw treatment from his friends.</i>



salmon	The flesh of the salmon as food. Cotton checked throw in cream and salmon pink.
shark	A small SE Asian freshwater fish with a tail resembling that of a shark popular in aquaria. As soon as he arrived he was shark ing among the women.
spermaceti	A white waxy substance produced by the sperm whale, formerly used in candles and ointments. It is present in a rounded organ in the head, where it focuses acoustic signals and aids in the control of buoyancy.
steak	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. A fillet steak .
<u>succulent</u>	A succulent plant. <i>Succulent</i> roast beef.
tuna	The flesh of the tuna as food.
uncooked	Not cooked; raw. Frozen ready meals may be completely uncooked .
vegetarian	Relating to vegetarians or vegetarianism. A vegetarian restaurant.
whale	Hunt for whales.
whaler	A ship engaged in whale fishing.
