tail	Remove or shorten the tail of an animal. <i>He stormed off the tails of his jacket flapping behind him.</i>
tom	A black man considered to be excessively obedient or servile to white people. It was insulting to hold out my hand and have a clerk bang the money down I d tom med again.
tonsure	Shave the hair on top of a monk s or priest s head give a tonsure to. <i>He received the tonsure.</i>
