## Associations of "Bombarded" (30 Words)

<a href="#">arm</a>	Any projection that is thought to resemble a human arm. <i>The <b>arm</b> of the record player.</i>
artillery	Large but transportable armament. <i>Tanks and heavy <b>artillery</b>.</i>
<a href="#">assail</a>	Criticize strongly. <i>He <b>assailed</b> a group of editors for their alleged excesses.</i>
blast	Kick or strike (a ball) hard. <i>Your reputation is <b>blasted</b> already in the village.</i>
bomb	Make someone homeless by destroying their home with bombs. <i>My family were <b>bombed</b> out while I was fighting.</i>
bombardier	The member of a bomber crew responsible for using the bombsight and releasing the bombs on the target.
bomber	A bomber jacket. <i>Manny hand rolled a couple of <b>bombers</b>.</i>
burst	Cause to burst. <i>Her breath was coming in short <b>bursts</b>.</i>
cannon	Make a cannon. <i>The couple behind almost <b>cannoned</b> into us.</i>
detonate	Cause to burst with a violent release of energy. <i>Two other bombs failed to <b>detonate</b>.</i>
detonation	The action of causing a bomb or explosive device to explode. <i>Natural gas s high resistance to <b>detonation</b>.</i>
<a href="#">explode</a>	Suddenly begin to move or start a new activity. <i>An ammunition lorry <b>exploded</b> with a roar.</i>
<a href="#">explosion</a>	The noise caused by an explosion. <i>The information <b>explosion</b>.</i>

<b>explosive</b>	Likely to cause an outburst of anger or controversy. <i><b>Explosive</b> gas.</i>
<b>fighter</b>	A person who does not easily admit defeat in spite of difficulties or opposition. <i>World War II <b>fighter</b> planes.</i>
<b>firing</b>	The act of firing weapons or artillery at an enemy. <i>The recent <b>firing</b> of the head of the department.</i>
<b>flak</b>	A slick spokesperson who can turn any criticism to the advantage of their employer. <i>Don t give me any <b>flak</b>.</i>
<b>gun</b>	A professional killer who uses a gun. <i>It s encouraging to note that Schwarzenegger wasn t born with massive <b>guns</b>.</i>
<b>gunner</b>	A member of an aircraft crew who operates a gun, especially (formerly) in a gun turret on a bomber.
<b>implode</b>	Burst inward. <i>The bottle <b>imploded</b>.</i>
<b>missile</b>	A weapon that is forcibly thrown or projected at a targets but is not self-propelled. <i>The USAF approach uses small <b>missiles</b> fired from conventional fighter aircraft.</i>
<b>musket</b>	A muzzle-loading shoulder gun with a long barrel; formerly used by infantrymen. <i>A volley of <b>musket</b> fire.</i>
<b>nuclear</b>	Denoting possessing or involving weapons using nuclear energy. <i><b>Nuclear</b> submarines.</i>
<b>ordnance</b>	Munitions. <i>The gun was a brand new piece of <b>ordnance</b>.</i>
<b>rifle</b>	A shoulder firearm with a long barrel and a rifled bore. <i>There are four basic ways to <b>rifle</b> a gun barrel.</i>
<b>salvo</b>	An outburst resembling the discharge of firearms or the release of bombs. <i>Another <b>salvo</b> crashed nearer to the German positions.</i>
<b>shot</b>	Tiny lead pellets used in quantity in a single charge or cartridge in a shotgun. <i>They have fired the opening <b>shot</b> in what s expected to be a savage price war.</i>
<b>tank</b>	Fill the tank of a vehicle with fuel. <i>Rangers <b>tanked</b> the local side 8 0.</i>

weapon

A thing designed or used for inflicting bodily harm or physical damage.

*He used all his conversational **weapons**.*
