<u>arm</u>	A thing comparable to an arm in form or function typically something that projects from a larger structure. They have extended the arm of friendship to developing countries.
artillery	Large-calibre guns used in warfare on land. Each corps included two regiments of field artillery .
<u>assail</u>	Make a concerted or violent attack on. Nightmares assail ed him regularly.
blast	Move very quickly and loudly in a specified direction. Four low flying jets blast ed down the glen.
bomb	Attack a place or object with a bomb or bombs. The Americans bomb ed Dresden.
bombardier	A noncommissioned officer in the British artillery.
bomber	A bomber jacket. Manny hand rolled a couple of bomber s.
burst	The act of exploding or bursting. The sun burst into view.
cannon	Make a cannon shot. They would cross at the Town ford under cover of the defending cannon .
detonate	Explode or cause to explode. The bomb detonate d at noon.
detonation	The action of causing a bomb or explosive device to explode. Natural gas s high resistance to detonation .
<u>explode</u>	Drive from the stage by noisy disapproval. <i>This is ludicrous she exploded</i> .
<u>explosion</u>	The noise caused by an explosion. There will have to be sweeping changes if the political leaders want to avoid an explosion .



explosive	Serving to explode or characterized by explosion or sudden outburst. <i>Explosive</i> gas.
fighter	A person or animal that fights. The distinction between civilian populations and fighter s.
firing	The act of firing weapons or artillery at an enemy. A series of firing s and resignations.
flak	Anti-aircraft fire. You must be strong enough to take the flak if things go wrong.
<u>gun</u>	Shoot with a gun. A grease gun .
gunner	A member of the armed forces who operates or specializes in guns.
implode	End or fail suddenly or dramatically. <i>He lost money when the market imploded</i> .
missile	A weapon that is self-propelled or directed by remote control, carrying conventional or nuclear explosive. The plane disintegrated after being hit by a missile launched from the ground.
musket	An infantryman's light gun with a long barrel, typically smooth-bored and fired from the shoulder. A volley of musket fire.
nuclear	Denoting relating to or powered by the energy released in nuclear fission or fusion. <i>Nuclear</i> physics.
ordnance	Munitions. The ordnance corps.
rifle	A shoulder firearm with a long barrel and a rifled bore. Ferguson rifle d home his fourth goal of the season.
salvo	A sudden, vigorous, or aggressive act or series of acts. The pardons provoked a salvo of accusations.
shot	A ball of stone or metal used as a missile shot from a large gun or cannon. <i>The nurse gave him a flu shot</i> .
<u>tank</u>	Treat in a tank. Tank animal refuse.
<u>war</u>	Make or wage war. A price war among tour operators.
<u>weapon</u>	Any instrument or instrumentality used in fighting or hunting. <i>Resignation threats had long been a weapon in his armoury.</i>
