- *An attack by dropping bombs.*
- *An event that fails badly or is totally ineffectual.*
- *An explosive device fused to explode under specific conditions.*
- *The use of bombs for sabotage; a tactic frequently used by terrorists.*
- *An act or instance of dropping or detonating a bomb somewhere.*
- *Strong sealed vessel for measuring heat of combustion.*



## Synonyms of "Bombing" as a noun (17 Words)

<b>blasting</b>	A sudden very loud noise.
<b>blowing up</b>	Processing that involves blowing a gas.
<b>bombardment</b>	A continuous attack with bombs, shells, or other missiles. <i>A steady <b>bombardment</b> of emails and phone calls.</i>
<b>breaking up</b>	The act of breaking something.
<b>carpet bombing</b>	Floor covering consisting of a piece of thick heavy fabric (usually with nap or pile).
<b>demolition</b>	An event (or the result of an event) that completely destroys something. <i>The <b>demolition</b> of the huge tower was quite a spectacle.</i>
<b>dismantling</b>	The act of taking something apart (as a piece of machinery). <i>Russia and the United States discussed the <b>dismantling</b> of their nuclear weapons.</i>
<b>felling</b>	The act of felling something as a tree.

<b>knocking down</b>	The act of hitting vigorously.
<b>levelling</b>	A structure consisting of a room or set of rooms at a single position along a vertical scale.
<b>pulling down</b>	The force used in pulling.
<b>razing</b>	The event of a structure being completely demolished and leveled.
<b>ruination</b>	The action or fact of ruining someone or something or of being ruined. <i>The headquarters fell into <b>ruination</b>.</i>
<b>shattering</b>	The act of breaking something into small pieces.
<b>smashing</b>	The act of breaking something into small pieces.
<b>tearing down</b>	The act of tearing.
<b>wrecking</b>	The event of a structure being completely demolished and leveled. <i>His main business was <b>wrecking</b> and removal.</i>

## Associations of "Bombing" (30 Words)

### ammunition

Any nuclear or chemical or biological material that can be used as a weapon of mass destruction.

An **ammunition** dump.

### assail

Launch an attack or assault on; begin hostilities or start warfare with.

*Nightmares **assailed** him regularly.*

<b>blast</b>	Force or throw (something) in a specified direction by impact or explosion. <i>Four low flying jets <b>blasted</b> down the glen.</i>
<b><u>bombard</u></b>	Address with continuously or persistently, as if with a barrage. <i>The city was <b>bombarded</b> by federal forces.</i>
<b>bombardier</b>	A member of a bomber crew in the US air force responsible for aiming and releasing bombs.
<b>burst</b>	Burst outward usually with noise. <i>The sun <b>burst</b> into view.</i>
<b>cannon</b>	Make a cannon. <i>The couple behind almost <b>cannoned</b> into us.</i>
<b>demolition</b>	An event (or the result of an event) that completely destroys something. <i>Ireland's <b>demolition</b> of England.</i>
<b>detonate</b>	Explode or cause to explode. <i>Two other bombs failed to <b>detonate</b>.</i>
<b>detonation</b>	A violent release of energy caused by a chemical or nuclear reaction. <i>Natural gas's high resistance to <b>detonation</b>.</i>
<b>eruption</b>	The emergence of a tooth as it breaks through the gum. <i>Irritable skin <b>eruptions</b>.</i>
<b><u>explode</u></b>	(of a violent emotion or a situation) arise or develop suddenly. <i>Lead ensures that petrol burns rather than <b>explodes</b>.</i>
<b><u>explosion</u></b>	The noise caused by an explosion. <i>An <b>explosion</b> of laughter.</i>
<b>explosive</b>	Able or likely to shatter violently or burst apart. <i>An <b>explosive</b> device.</i>
<b>firearm</b>	A rifle, pistol, or other portable gun. <i>Jones pleaded guilty to possessing a <b>firearm</b> with criminal intent.</i>
<b>firework</b>	A device with an explosive that burns at a low rate and with colored flames; can be used to illuminate areas or send signals etc. <i>They were oohing and aahing as if they were watching the <b>fireworks</b>.</i>
<b>flak</b>	Anti-aircraft fire. <i>He has been getting <b>flak</b> from certain quarters lately for pointing this out.</i>
<b>fulminate</b>	Criticize severely. <i>He <b>fulminated</b> against the evils of his time.</i>
<b>grenade</b>	A small bomb thrown by hand or launched mechanically.
<b>gunner</b>	A member of the armed forces who operates or specializes in guns.

<b>implode</b>	Collapse or cause to collapse violently inwards. <i>The plasma <b>implodes</b> the fuel.</i>
<b>nuclear</b>	Denoting possessing or involving weapons using nuclear energy. <i>Annexation of the suburban fringe by the <b>nuclear</b> metropolis.</i>
<b>ordnance</b>	Military supplies. <i>The <b>ordnance</b> corps.</i>
<b>outburst</b>	A sudden release of strong emotion. <i>An <b>outburst</b> of heavy rain.</i>
<b>pyrotechnic</b>	Brilliant or sensational. <i><b>Pyrotechnic</b> keyboard virtuosity.</i>
<b>pyrotechnics</b>	The art of making or displaying fireworks. <i>He thrilled his audience with vocal <b>pyrotechnics</b>.</i>
<b>rifle</b>	A shoulder firearm with a long barrel and a rifled bore. <i>There are four basic ways to <b>rifle</b> a gun barrel.</i>
<b>thermonuclear</b>	Relating to or involving weapons in which explosive force is produced by thermonuclear reactions. <i><b>Thermonuclear</b> fusion.</i>
<u><a href="#">war</a></u>	A legal state created by a declaration of war and ended by official declaration during which the international rules of war apply. <i>A <b>war</b> of wits.</i>
<u><a href="#">weapon</a></u>	A means of gaining an advantage or defending oneself in a conflict or contest. <i>Nuclear <b>weapons</b>.</i>
