## Associations of "Bone of contention" (30 Words)

<a href="#">bony</a>	Of or like bone. <i>He held up his <b>bony</b> fingers.</i>
<b>brawn</b>	Physical strength in contrast to intelligence. <i>A slice of <b>brawn</b>.</i>
<b>cadaverous</b>	Very pale, thin, or bony. <i>We had long anticipated his <b>cadaverous</b> end.</i>
<b>cartilage</b>	A particular structure made of cartilage. <i>His knees failed and the <b>cartilages</b> were removed.</i>
<b>cerebrum</b>	The principal and most anterior part of the brain in vertebrates, located in the front area of the skull and consisting of two hemispheres, left and right, separated by a fissure. It is responsible for the integration of complex sensory and neural functions and the initiation and coordination of voluntary activity in the body.
<b>chewing</b>	Biting and grinding food in your mouth so it becomes soft enough to swallow.
<b>clavicle</b>	Bone linking the scapula and sternum.
<b>cranial</b>	Of or relating to the cranium which encloses the brain.
<b>cranium</b>	The skull, especially the part enclosing the brain.
<b>dislocate</b>	Move from its proper place or position. <i>The symbol is <b>dislocated</b> from its political context.</i>
<a href="#">fracture</a>	Become fractured. <i>It was a nasty <b>fracture</b>.</i>
<b>framework</b>	A hypothetical description of a complex entity or process. <i>A conservatory in a delicate <b>framework</b> of iron.</i>
<a href="#">gaunt</a>	Very thin especially from disease or hunger or cold. <i>A tall <b>gaunt</b> woman in black.</i>
<b>gristle</b>	Tough elastic tissue; mostly converted to bone in adults.

<b>haggard</b>	A haggard hawk. <i>Her face was drawn and <b>haggard</b> from sleeplessness.</i>
<b>incisor</b>	A narrow edged tooth at the front of the mouth adapted for cutting In humans there are four incisors in each jaw.
<b>jaw</b>	The lower movable bone of the jaw or the part of the face containing it. <i>A passenger stepping from the <b>jaws</b> of a car ferry.</i>
<b>knee</b>	Joint between the femur and tibia in a quadruped corresponds to the human knee. <i>They were eating their suppers on their <b>knees</b>.</i>
<b>kneecap</b>	Shoot in the kneecap often done by terrorist groups as a warning. <i>Petty crimes are punished by <b>kneecapping</b>.</i>
<b>mandible</b>	Either of the upper and lower parts of a bird's beak. <i>The drake is all black except for an orange mark on the upper <b>mandible</b>.</i>
<b>muscle</b>	A muscle or muscles when well developed or prominently visible under the skin. <i>The calf <b>muscle</b>.</i>
<b>osseous</b>	Composed of or containing bone. <i><b>Osseous</b> tissue.</i>
<b>rib</b>	A riblike supporting or strengthening part of an animal or plant. <i>Knit twenty rows of <b>rib</b>.</i>
<b>rivalry</b>	Competition for the same objective or for superiority in the same field. <i>There always has been intense <b>rivalry</b> between the clubs.</i>
<b>shoulder</b>	Lift onto one's shoulders. <i>All accounts place the blame squarely on his <b>shoulders</b>.</i>
<b>sinew</b>	A cord or band of inelastic tissue connecting a muscle with its bony attachment. <i>It has been building the <b>sinews</b> of an independent state.</i>
<b>skeletal</b>	Existing only in outline or as a framework of something. <i>The <b>skeletal</b> remains of aquatic organisms.</i>
<b>skeleton</b>	A sport in which a competitor races down a frozen track on a skeleton sled. <i>The Canadian men's <b>skeleton</b> team.</i>
<b>skull</b>	Hit (someone) on the head. <i>He broke his collar bone and fractured his <b>skull</b>.</i>
<b>tissue</b>	Tissue paper. <i><b>Tissue</b> textiles.</i>
