Associations of "Bought" (30 Words)

acquire	Learn or develop (a skill, habit, or quality). <i>Children acquire language at an amazing rate.</i>
acquisition	Something acquired, typically a skill. <i>The acquisition of self control.</i>
acquisition	The cognitive process of acquiring skill or knowledge. <i>The acquisition of management skills.</i>
auction	Sell at an auction. <i>The painting was auctioned at Christie s.</i>
bargain	An agreement between parties (usually arrived at after discussion) fixing obligations of each. <i>She got a bargain at the auction.</i>
bidding	The prices offered during the course of bidding for something. <i>Women came running at his bidding.</i>
buyer	A person who buys.
chaffer	Haggle about the terms of an agreement or price of something. <i>I chaffered in the bazaars for objects I wanted.</i>
cheap	Tastelessly showy. <i>Local buses were reliable and cheap.</i>
coupon	Of a consumer collect and use coupons or vouchers offering discounts on goods or services. <i>She couponed and budgeted to feed her family of six.</i>
deal	The set of hands dealt to the players. <i>He rose to prominence through a series of shady deals.</i>
discount	Give a reduction in price on. <i>I d heard rumours but discounted them.</i>
grantee	Someone to whom the title of property is transferred.

haggle	Wrangle (over a price, terms of an agreement, etc. <i>Let s not haggle over a few dollars.</i>
<u>inexpensive</u>	Not costing a great deal; cheap. <i>Inexpensive family restaurants.</i>
mall	An alley used for pall mall. <i>They spent their weekends at the local malls.</i>
price	Discover or establish the price of something for sale. <i>The price of gasoline.</i>
purchase	Obtain by purchase acquire by means of a financial transaction. <i>The large number of videos currently available for purchase.</i>
purchaser	A person who buys. <i>One of the club s prospective purchasers.</i>
rebate	Pay back a sum of money as a rebate. <i>You will be entitled to a 20 per cent rebate off each standard fare.</i>
sell	Sell all of one s stock of something. <i>The store sells hi fis TVs videos and other electrical goods.</i>
<u>seller</u>	Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money. <i>The book became the biggest seller in the history of royal publishing.</i>
selling	The exchange of goods for an agreed sum of money.
shopping	The commodities purchased from storeswomen carrying home shopping didn t give me a second glance. <i>Women carrying home shopping didn t give me a second glance.</i>
supermarket	A large self-service grocery store selling groceries and dairy products and household goods.
<u>tax</u>	Impose a tax on someone or something. <i>Why are you taxing me with these preposterous allegations.</i>
transact	Conduct business. <i>The dealer must know the price at which he is prepared to transact.</i>
transferee	(law) someone to whom a title or property is conveyed.
voucher	A small printed piece of paper that entitles the holder to a discount, or that may be exchanged for goods or services.
wholesale	At a wholesale price. <i>The safety clauses seem to have been taken wholesale from union documents.</i>
