Synonyms of "Bouncer" as a noun (5 Words)

chucker-out	A person whose duty is to throw troublemakers out of a bar or public meeting.
nightwatchman	An inferior batsman sent in to bat when a wicket falls just before the end of a day's play, to avoid the dismissal of a better one in adverse conditions.
security guard	Measures taken as a precaution against theft or espionage or sabotage etc.
sentinel	A soldier or guard whose job is to stand and keep watch. A sentinel surveillance programme for influenza.
sentry	A soldier stationed to keep guard or to control access to a place. Two men stood sentry on the door every evening.
