Definitions of "Bouncer" as a noun

- *A person whose duty is to throw troublemakers out of a bar or public meeting.*
- *A ball bowled fast and short so as to rise high after pitching.*



Synonyms of "Bouncer" as a noun (5 Words)

- chucker-out** A person whose duty is to throw troublemakers out of a bar or public meeting.
- nightwatchman** An inferior batsman sent in to bat when a wicket falls just before the end of a day's play, to avoid the dismissal of a better one in adverse conditions.
- security guard** Measures taken as a precaution against theft or espionage or sabotage etc.
- sentinel** A soldier or guard whose job is to stand and keep watch.
A **sentinel** surveillance programme for influenza.
- sentry** A soldier stationed to keep guard or to control access to a place.
Two men stood **sentry** on the door every evening.
