<u>accolade</u>	An award or privilege granted as a special honour or as an acknowledgement of merit. <i>Poignant accolades and urgent testimonials of thanks.</i>
<u>aroma</u>	A distinctive, typically pleasant smell. <i>The aroma of officialdom.</i>
bunch of flowers	Any collection in its entirety.
commendation	Formal or official praise. <i>The book gives commendations for initiative.</i>
<u>compliment</u>	Congratulations or praise expressed to someone. <i>She paid me an enormous compliment.</i>
corsage	The upper part of a woman's dress.
<u>eulogy</u>	A formal expression of praise. <i>A eulogy to the Queen Mother.</i>

fragrance	A perfume or aftershave. <i>The fragrance of fresh ground coffee.</i>
fragrancy	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
nose	A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft. <i>He pushed his glasses higher on to the bridge of his nose.</i>
nosegay	An arrangement of flowers that is usually given as a present. <i>A nosegay worn at the waist or bodice.</i>
odour	The state of being held in a specified regard. <i>A decade of bad odour between Britain and the European Community.</i>
paean	(ancient Greece) a hymn of praise (especially one sung in ancient Greece to invoke or thank a deity). <i>He s created a filmic paean to his hero.</i>
panegyric	A formal expression of praise. <i>A panegyric on the pleasures of malt whisky.</i>
perfume	A fragrant liquid typically made from essential oils extracted from flowers and spices, used to give a pleasant smell to one's body. <i>I caught a whiff of her fresh lemony perfume.</i>
plaudit	An expression of praise or approval. <i>The plaudits for the winner died down.</i>
posy	A small bunch of flowers.
redolence	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
savour	The taste experience when a savoury condiment is taken into the mouth. <i>The subtle savour of wood smoke.</i>
scent	Any property detected by the olfactory system. <i>She sprayed scent over her body.</i>
smell	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>Lingering kitchen smells.</i>
spray	A can or container holding a spray. <i>A fine spray of mud.</i>
sprig	A small moulded decoration applied to a piece of pottery before firing. <i>A sprig of the French nobility.</i>
sweetness	English phonetician; one of the founders of modern phonetics (1845-1912). <i>I ve just got to go sweetness.</i>
tang	A tart spicy quality. <i>His words came out with a distinct tang of broad Lancashire.</i>

- tribute** Something resulting from a particular quality or feature and indicating its worth.
*An Abba **tribute** band.*
- whiff** A trace or hint of something bad, menacing, or exciting.
***Whiffs** of smoke emerged from the boiler.*

- *We will happily publish the bouquets and brickbats.*

*The **aroma** of officialdom.*
- aromatic** An aromatic compound.
*A massage with **aromatic** oils.*
- blending** The act of blending components together thoroughly.
*The **blending** of drinkable yogurt with fruit juice.*

bridal	Of or relating to a wedding. <i>The bridal party came out into the church porch.</i>
bride	Irish abbess; a patron saint of Ireland (453-523). <i>The bride and groom left early last night.</i>
bridegroom	A man on his wedding day or just before and after the event.
claying	Overly sweet. <i>A romantic rather claying story.</i>
cosmetic	A toiletry designed to beautify the body. <i>Cosmetic fenders on cars.</i>
dowry	Money or property brought by a woman to her husband at marriage. <i>Elizabeth's dowry was to be 45 000 in diamonds.</i>
floral	A fabric with a floral design. <i>An unusual floral design.</i>
flower	Produce or yield flowers. <i>Michaelmas daisies can flower as late as October.</i>
flowery	Covered with flowers or having a floral design. <i>Flowery wallpaper.</i>
fragrance	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property. <i>The fragrance of fresh ground coffee.</i>
groom	A bridegroom. <i>The horses were groomed and taken to shows.</i>
honeymoon	Spend a honeymoon. <i>They flew to the West Indies on honeymoon.</i>
incense	The smoke or perfume of incense. <i>Incense sticks.</i>
marry	Splice (rope ends) together without increasing their girth. <i>Eric asked me to marry him.</i>
nectary	A nectar-secreting glandular organ in a flower (floral) or on a leaf or stem (extrafloral).
nosegay	An arrangement of flowers that is usually given as a present. <i>A nosegay worn at the waist or bodice.</i>
odor	The sensation that results when olfactory receptors in the nose are stimulated by particular chemicals in gaseous form.
perfume	Impregnate with perfume or a sweet smelling substance. <i>Just one bloom of jasmine has the power to perfume a whole room.</i>
perfumery	The art of making perfumes. <i>A department store perfumery.</i>

- powder** A medicine or drug in the form of powder usually designed to be dissolved in a liquid.
*Then the rose petals are dried and **powdered**.*
- preen** Congratulate or pride oneself.
*It did not prevent them from **preening** themselves on their achievement.*
- scent** Catch the scent of get wind of.
*I got word that other reporters had picked up the **scent**.*
- smell** Smell bad.
*It had the **smell** of treason.*
- sweet** The sweet part or element of something.
*The **sweet** face of a child.*
- wedding** A party of people at a wedding.
