<b>nose</b>	A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft. <i>He pushed his glasses higher on to the bridge of his <b>nose</b>.</i>
<b>nosegay</b>	An arrangement of flowers that is usually given as a present. <i>A <b>nosegay</b> worn at the waist or bodice.</i>
<b>odour</b>	The state of being held in a specified regard. <i>A decade of bad <b>odour</b> between Britain and the European Community.</i>
<b>paean</b>	(ancient Greece) a hymn of praise (especially one sung in ancient Greece to invoke or thank a deity). <i>He s created a filmic <b>paean</b> to his hero.</i>
<b>panegyric</b>	A formal expression of praise. <i>A <b>panegyric</b> on the pleasures of malt whisky.</i>
<b>perfume</b>	A fragrant liquid typically made from essential oils extracted from flowers and spices, used to give a pleasant smell to one's body. <i>I caught a whiff of her fresh lemony <b>perfume</b>.</i>
<b>plaudit</b>	An expression of praise or approval. <i>The <b>plaudits</b> for the winner died down.</i>
<b>posy</b>	A small bunch of flowers.
<b>redolence</b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
<b>savour</b>	The taste experience when a savoury condiment is taken into the mouth. <i>The subtle <b>savour</b> of wood smoke.</i>
<b>scent</b>	Any property detected by the olfactory system. <i>She sprayed <b>scent</b> over her body.</i>
<b>smell</b>	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>Lingering kitchen <b>smells</b>.</i>
<b>spray</b>	A can or container holding a spray. <i>A fine <b>spray</b> of mud.</i>
<b>sprig</b>	A small moulded decoration applied to a piece of pottery before firing. <i>A <b>sprig</b> of the French nobility.</i>
<b>sweetness</b>	English phonetician; one of the founders of modern phonetics (1845-1912). <i>I ve just got to go <b>sweetness</b>.</i>
<b>tang</b>	A tart spicy quality. <i>His words came out with a distinct <b>tang</b> of broad Lancashire.</i>

- tribute**                    Something resulting from a particular quality or feature and indicating its worth.  
*An Abba **tribute** band.*
- whiff**                      A trace or hint of something bad, menacing, or exciting.  
***Whiffs** of smoke emerged from the boiler.*

<b>claying</b>	Overly sweet. <i>A romantic rather <b>claying</b> story.</i>
<b>cosmetic</b>	A toiletry designed to beautify the body. <i><b>Cosmetic</b> fenders on cars.</i>
<b>dowry</b>	Money or property brought by a woman to her husband at marriage. <i>Elizabeth's <b>dowry</b> was to be 45 000 in diamonds.</i>
<b>floral</b>	A fabric with a floral design. <i>An unusual <b>floral</b> design.</i>
<b>flower</b>	Produce or yield flowers. <i>Michaelmas daisies can <b>flower</b> as late as October.</i>
<b>flowery</b>	Covered with flowers or having a floral design. <i><b>Flowery</b> wallpaper.</i>
<b>fragrance</b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property. <i>The <b>fragrance</b> of fresh ground coffee.</i>
<b>groom</b>	A bridegroom. <i>The horses were <b>groomed</b> and taken to shows.</i>
<b>honeymoon</b>	Spend a honeymoon. <i>They flew to the West Indies on <b>honeymoon</b>.</i>
<b>incense</b>	The smoke or perfume of incense. <i><b>Incense</b> sticks.</i>
<b>marry</b>	Splice (rope ends) together without increasing their girth. <i>Eric asked me to <b>marry</b> him.</i>
<b>nectary</b>	A nectar-secreting glandular organ in a flower (floral) or on a leaf or stem (extrafloral).
<b>nosegay</b>	An arrangement of flowers that is usually given as a present. <i>A <b>nosegay</b> worn at the waist or bodice.</i>
<b>odor</b>	The sensation that results when olfactory receptors in the nose are stimulated by particular chemicals in gaseous form.
<b>perfume</b>	Impregnate with perfume or a sweet smelling substance. <i>Just one bloom of jasmine has the power to <b>perfume</b> a whole room.</i>
<b>perfumery</b>	The art of making perfumes. <i>A department store <b>perfumery</b>.</i>

*It had the **smell** of treason.*
- sweet** The sweet part or element of something.  
*The **sweet** face of a child.*
- wedding** A party of people at a wedding.
