Definitions of "Bourgeois" as an adjective

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "bourgeois" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Belonging to the middle class.
- (according to Marxist thought) being of the property-owning class and exploitive of the working class.
- \bullet Conforming to the standards and conventions of the middle class.
- (in Marxist contexts) upholding the interests of capitalism; not communist.
- Belonging to or characteristic of the middle class, typically with reference to its perceived materialistic values or conventional attitudes.
- Being of the property-owning class and exploitive of the working class.
