Associations of "Bow out" (30 Words)

aloha	An utterance of aloha. <i>The aloha spirit.</i>
aquiline	(of a person's nose) hooked or curved like an eagle's beak.
arc	Form an electric arc. <i>The outage was caused by a bad switch that arced.</i>
archer	(astrology) a person who is born while the sun is in Sagittarius.
archery	Shooting with a bow and arrows, especially at a target as a sport.
badminton	A game played on a court with light long-handled rackets used to volley a shuttlecock over a net.
bend	Bend one's back forward from the waist on down. <i>They want to bend me to their will.</i>
bent	Homosexual (typically used of a man). <i>A piece of bent wire.</i>
bowstring	Strangle with a bowstring a former Turkish method of execution.
bye	A farewell remark. <i>He had a bye in the first round.</i>
condescend	Treat condescendingly. <i>Take care not to condescend to your reader.</i>
crouch	A crouching stance or posture. <i>He crouched down.</i>
cudgel	Strike with a cudgel. <i>They would lie in wait and cudgel her to death.</i>
curve	Curved segment of a road or river or railroad track etc. <i>Her dress twisted tightly round her generous curves.</i>
ductile	Capable of being shaped or bent or drawn out. <i>Ductile copper.</i>

exhale	Breathe out. <i>The jungle exhaled mists of early morning.</i>
fencing	The erection of fences. <i>The horse makes his fencing debut today.</i>
flex	The action or state of flexing. <i>She saw him flex his ankle and wince.</i>
flexibly	In a way that bends easily without breaking. <i>The ability of governments to respond flexibly to changing economic circumstances.</i>
fold	Become folded or folded up. <i>Fold up the newspaper.</i>
goodbye	An instance of saying goodbye a parting. <i>We said our goodbyes and set off.</i>
greeting	A polite word or sign of welcome or recognition. <i>Mandy shouted a greeting.</i>
hi	A state in the United States in the central Pacific on the Hawaiian Islands.
hooked	Curved down like an eagle's beak. <i>A girl who got hooked on cocaine.</i>
pucker	Draw together into folds or puckers. <i>The baby stirred puckering up its face.</i>
refract	Subject to refraction. <i>When refracting patients an ophthalmologist relies on verbal reports.</i>
salutation	(usually plural) an acknowledgment or expression of good will (especially on meeting). <i>He raised his glass in salutation.</i>
shield	A sporting trophy shaped like a shield consisting of an engraved metal plate mounted on a piece of wood. <i>A face shield is sometimes an integral part of a safety helmet.</i>
stoop	Bend one's back forward from the waist on down. <i>I won't stoop to reading other people's mail.</i>
winding	The act of winding or twisting. <i>The windings of the stream.</i>
