Bower as a Noun

Definitions of "Bower" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “bower” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A summer house or country cottage.*
- *A framework that supports climbing plants.*
- *A pleasant shady place under trees or climbing plants in a garden or wood.*
- *A woman's private room or bedroom.*



Synonyms of "Bower" as a noun (13 Words)

- alcove** A small recess opening off a larger room.
- arbor** Tree (as opposed to shrub).
*The **arbor** provided a shady resting place in the park.*
- arbour** A framework that supports climbing plants.
- bedchamber** A room used primarily for sleeping.
- bedroom** Denoting a small town or suburb whose residents commute to a nearby city.
*She revealed the couple's **bedroom** secrets.*
- boudoir** A lady's bedroom or private sitting room.
- chamber** A judge's office, where proceedings may be held if not required to be held in open court.
*The **chambers** of his heart were healthy.*

- dressing room** Savory dressings for salads; basically of two kinds: either the thin French or vinaigrette type or the creamy mayonnaise type.
- grotto** A small cave (usually with attractive features).
*Visits to Father Christmas s **grotto**.*
- pergola** A framework that supports climbing plants.
- recess** A small space created by building part of a wall further back from the rest.
*Parliament was in **recess**.*
- room** The people who are present in a room.
*He was trapped without **room** to move.*
- sanctuary** A nature reserve.
*His sons took **sanctuary** in the church.*



Bower as a Verb

Definitions of "Bower" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "bower" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Shade or enclose (a place or person).*
- *Enclose in a bower.*



Synonyms of "Bower" as a verb (1 Word)

Surround or shelter (a place or a person), especially with trees or climbing **embower** plants.

*The house stood remote **embowered** in trees.*



Usage Examples of "Bower" as a verb

- *Trees here and there bowered the cottages.*
