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## Associations of "Brainwashed" (30 Words)

<b>bath</b>	A bathroom. <i>There was no hot water to <b>bath</b> in.</i>
<a href="#">bathe</a>	Suffuse with or as if with light. <i>They <b>bathed</b> the baby.</i>
<b>clean</b>	Make clean remove dirt marks or stains from. <i>A spotlessly <b>clean</b> house.</i>
<a href="#">cleaner</a>	A device for cleaning such as a vacuum cleaner. <i>She s one of the office <b>cleaners</b>.</i>
<b>cleanse</b>	Rid of something unpleasant or defiling. <i>This preparation will <b>cleanse</b> and tighten the skin.</i>
<b>coercive</b>	Serving or intended to coerce. <i>Authority is directional instead of <b>coercive</b>.</i>
<b>detoxify</b>	Remove poison from. <i>If they are not able to <b>detoxify</b> in their normal environment then they will never come off drugs.</i>
<b>effervescence</b>	Bubbles in a liquid; fizz. <i>He was filled with such <b>effervescence</b>.</i>
<b>indoctrinate</b>	Teach or instruct (someone). <i>The Moonies <b>indoctrinate</b> their disciples.</i>
<b>laundress</b>	A working woman who takes in washing.
<b>laundry</b>	Workplace where clothes are washed and ironed. <i>Lots of people send their sheets to a <b>laundry</b> these days.</i>
<b>locomotive</b>	(of a machine, vehicle, or animal) having the power of progressive motion. <i>A diesel <b>locomotive</b>.</i>
<a href="#">maneuver</a>	A plan for attaining a particular goal. <i>He made a great <b>maneuver</b>.</i>

<b>manipulate</b>	Manipulate in a fraudulent manner. <i>He <b>manipulated</b> public opinion in his favor.</i>
<b>napkin</b>	A baby's nappy. <i>She unfolded her <b>napkin</b> and put it on her lap.</i>
<b>persuasion</b>	The act of persuading (or attempting to persuade); communication intended to induce belief or action. <i>The village had two chapels for those of the Primitive Methodist <b>persuasion</b>.</i>
<b>purge</b>	Physically remove or expel (something) completely. <i>Sufferers eat normally in summer but overeat and <b>purge</b> during winter.</i>
<b>purify</b>	Become clean or pure or free of guilt and sin. <i><b>Purify</b> the water.</i>
<b>sanctify</b>	Make legitimate or binding by a religious ceremony. <i>A small shrine was built to <b>sanctify</b> the site.</i>
<b>scheme</b>	Devise a system or form a scheme for. <i>Sheila and me were in that gang on the <b>scheme</b>.</i>
<b>shampoo</b>	An act of washing or cleaning something especially the hair with shampoo. <i>An anti dandruff <b>shampoo</b>.</i>
<b>shower</b>	Cause a mass of small things to fall in a shower. <i>She had a nice refreshing <b>shower</b>.</i>
<b>steer</b>	The type of steering of a vehicle. <i>The ship <b>steered</b> into port.</i>
<b>tactic</b>	The art of disposing armed forces in order of battle and of organizing operations, especially during contact with an enemy. <i>Basic infantry <b>tactics</b> were taught by guest instructors.</i>
<b>tactics</b>	The branch of military science dealing with detailed maneuvers to achieve objectives set by strategy.
<b>tub</b>	Plant in a tub. <i>A soak in the <b>tub</b>.</i>
<b>turbine</b>	A machine for producing continuous power in which a wheel or rotor, typically fitted with vanes, is made to revolve by a fast-moving flow of water, steam, gas, air, or other fluid.
<b>vacuum</b>	Clean with a vacuum cleaner. <i><b>Vacuum</b> the carpets.</i>
<b>wash</b>	An act of washing something or an instance of being washed. <i>He reached for the soap and began to <b>wash</b>.</i>
