bath	A bathroom. <i>There was no hot water to bath in.</i>
bathe	Suffuse with or as if with light. <i>They bathed the baby.</i>
clean	Make clean remove dirt marks or stains from. <i>A spotlessly clean house.</i>
cleaner	A device for cleaning such as a vacuum cleaner. <i>She s one of the office cleaners.</i>
cleanse	Rid of something unpleasant or defiling. <i>This preparation will cleanse and tighten the skin.</i>
coercive	Serving or intended to coerce. <i>Authority is directional instead of coercive.</i>
detoxify	Remove poison from. <i>If they are not able to detoxify in their normal environment then they will never come off drugs.</i>
effervescence	Bubbles in a liquid; fizz. <i>He was filled with such effervescence.</i>
indoctrinate	Teach or instruct (someone). <i>The Moonies indoctrinate their disciples.</i>
laundress	A working woman who takes in washing.
laundry	Workplace where clothes are washed and ironed. <i>Lots of people send their sheets to a laundry these days.</i>
locomotive	(of a machine, vehicle, or animal) having the power of progressive motion. <i>A diesel locomotive.</i>
maneuver	A plan for attaining a particular goal. <i>He made a great maneuver.</i>

manipulate	Manipulate in a fraudulent manner. <i>He manipulated public opinion in his favor.</i>
napkin	A baby's nappy. <i>She unfolded her napkin and put it on her lap.</i>
persuasion	The act of persuading (or attempting to persuade); communication intended to induce belief or action. <i>The village had two chapels for those of the Primitive Methodist persuasion.</i>
purge	Physically remove or expel (something) completely. <i>Sufferers eat normally in summer but overeat and purge during winter.</i>
purify	Become clean or pure or free of guilt and sin. <i>Purify the water.</i>
sanctify	Make legitimate or binding by a religious ceremony. <i>A small shrine was built to sanctify the site.</i>
scheme	Devise a system or form a scheme for. <i>Sheila and me were in that gang on the scheme.</i>
shampoo	An act of washing or cleaning something especially the hair with shampoo. <i>An anti dandruff shampoo.</i>
shower	Cause a mass of small things to fall in a shower. <i>She had a nice refreshing shower.</i>
steer	The type of steering of a vehicle. <i>The ship steered into port.</i>
tactic	The art of disposing armed forces in order of battle and of organizing operations, especially during contact with an enemy. <i>Basic infantry tactics were taught by guest instructors.</i>
tactics	The branch of military science dealing with detailed maneuvers to achieve objectives set by strategy.
tub	Plant in a tub. <i>A soak in the tub.</i>
turbine	A machine for producing continuous power in which a wheel or rotor, typically fitted with vanes, is made to revolve by a fast-moving flow of water, steam, gas, air, or other fluid.
vacuum	Clean with a vacuum cleaner. <i>Vacuum the carpets.</i>
wash	An act of washing something or an instance of being washed. <i>He reached for the soap and began to wash.</i>
