## Associations of "Branded" (30 Words)

<b>campaign</b>	Go on a campaign go off to war. <i>An advertising <b>campaign</b>.</i>
<b>capacity</b>	The susceptibility of something to a particular treatment. <i>The plant is working at 80 per cent <b>capacity</b>.</i>
<b>commodity</b>	Articles of commerce. <i>Water is a precious <b>commodity</b>.</i>
<b>company</b>	Accompany someone. <i>I m expecting <b>company</b>.</i>
<b>create</b>	Create or manufacture a man made product. <i>Little kids <b>create</b> because they hate being ignored.</i>
<b>distributor</b>	A company that markets merchandise. <i>A sports goods <b>distributor</b>.</i>
<b>fabricate</b>	Construct or manufacture (an industrial product), especially from prepared components. <i>You will have to <b>fabricate</b> an exhaust system.</i>
<b><u>forge</u></b>	Furnace consisting of a special hearth where metal is heated before shaping. <i>He <b>forged</b> ahead.</i>
<b>found</b>	Set up or found. <i>Collages of <b>found</b> photos.</i>
<b>infomercial</b>	A television commercial presented in the form of a short documentary.
<b><u>invent</u></b>	Come up with (an idea, plan, explanation, theory, or principle) after a mental effort. <i>I did not have to <b>invent</b> any tales about my past.</i>
<b><u>logo</u></b>	A company emblem or device. <i>The Olympic <b>logo</b> was emblazoned across the tracksuits.</i>

<b>make</b>	Make or cause to be or to become. <i>I <b>make</b> the height about 100 feet.</i>
<b>maker</b>	Terms referring to the Judeo-Christian God. <i>A cabinet<b>maker</b>.</i>
<b>making</b>	Usually plural the components needed for making or doing something. <i>The <b>making</b> of measurements.</i>
<b>manufacturer</b>	A business engaged in manufacturing some product. <i>The <b>manufacturers</b> supply the goods to the distribution centre.</i>
<b>manufacturing</b>	The making of articles on a large scale using machinery; industrial production. <i>Even in <b>manufacturing</b> they no longer dominate.</i>
<b>marketing</b>	The exchange of goods for an agreed sum of money. <i>A <b>marketing</b> campaign.</i>
<b>mascot</b>	A character, animal or object that is adopted by a team or group as a symbolic figure. <i>The team's dolphin <b>mascot</b>.</i>
<b>merchandise</b>	Engage in the trade of. <i>Shops which offered an astonishing range of <b>merchandise</b>.</i>
<b>motto</b>	A favorite saying of a sect or political group. <i>The family <b>motto</b> is Faithful though Unfortunate.</i>
<b>output</b>	Signal that comes out of an electronic system. <i>The computer is <b>outputting</b> the data from the job I'm running.</i>
<b>producer</b>	Someone who manufactures something. <i>This microorganism is a <b>producer</b> of disease.</i>
<b>product</b>	An article or substance that is manufactured or refined for sale. <i>A <b>product</b> of lime and nitric acid.</i>
<b>repairer</b>	A skilled worker who mends or repairs things.
<b>shibboleth</b>	A custom, principle, or belief distinguishing a particular class or group of people, especially a long-standing one regarded as outmoded or no longer important. <i>Liberal <b>shibboleths</b> about education.</i>
<b>slogan</b>	A short and striking or memorable phrase used in advertising. <i>Students were chanting <b>slogans</b>.</i>
<b>trademark</b>	Mark with a brand or trademark. <i>The company <b>trademarked</b> their new gadget.</i>

**truism** A proposition that states nothing beyond what is implied by any of its terms.

*The **truism** that you get what you pay for.*

**ware** Articles of the same kind or material usually used in combination  
silverware software.

*Traders in the street markets displayed their **wares**.*
