campaign	Go on a campaign go off to war. <i>An advertising campaign.</i>
capacity	The susceptibility of something to a particular treatment. <i>The plant is working at 80 per cent capacity.</i>
commodity	Articles of commerce. <i>Water is a precious commodity.</i>
company	Accompany someone. <i>I m expecting company.</i>
create	Create or manufacture a man made product. <i>Little kids create because they hate being ignored.</i>
distributor	A company that markets merchandise. <i>A sports goods distributor.</i>
fabricate	Construct or manufacture (an industrial product), especially from prepared components. <i>You will have to fabricate an exhaust system.</i>
<u>forge</u>	Furnace consisting of a special hearth where metal is heated before shaping. <i>He forged ahead.</i>
found	Set up or found. <i>Collages of found photos.</i>
infomercial	A television commercial presented in the form of a short documentary.
<u>invent</u>	Come up with (an idea, plan, explanation, theory, or principle) after a mental effort. <i>I did not have to invent any tales about my past.</i>
<u>logo</u>	A company emblem or device. <i>The Olympic logo was emblazoned across the tracksuits.</i>

make	Make or cause to be or to become. <i>I make the height about 100 feet.</i>
maker	Terms referring to the Judeo-Christian God. <i>A cabinetmaker.</i>
making	Usually plural the components needed for making or doing something. <i>The making of measurements.</i>
manufacturer	A business engaged in manufacturing some product. <i>The manufacturers supply the goods to the distribution centre.</i>
manufacturing	The making of articles on a large scale using machinery; industrial production. <i>Even in manufacturing they no longer dominate.</i>
marketing	The exchange of goods for an agreed sum of money. <i>A marketing campaign.</i>
mascot	A character, animal or object that is adopted by a team or group as a symbolic figure. <i>The team's dolphin mascot.</i>
merchandise	Engage in the trade of. <i>Shops which offered an astonishing range of merchandise.</i>
motto	A favorite saying of a sect or political group. <i>The family motto is Faithful though Unfortunate.</i>
output	Signal that comes out of an electronic system. <i>The computer is outputting the data from the job I'm running.</i>
producer	Someone who manufactures something. <i>This microorganism is a producer of disease.</i>
product	An article or substance that is manufactured or refined for sale. <i>A product of lime and nitric acid.</i>
repairer	A skilled worker who mends or repairs things.
shibboleth	A custom, principle, or belief distinguishing a particular class or group of people, especially a long-standing one regarded as outmoded or no longer important. <i>Liberal shibboleths about education.</i>
slogan	A short and striking or memorable phrase used in advertising. <i>Students were chanting slogans.</i>
trademark	Mark with a brand or trademark. <i>The company trademarked their new gadget.</i>

truism A proposition that states nothing beyond what is implied by any of its terms.

*The **truism** that you get what you pay for.*

ware Articles of the same kind or material usually used in combination
silverware software.
