Infinitive	to break-up
Present Tense	break-up / breaks-up
Past Tense	broke-up
Present Participle	breaking-up
Past Participle	broken-up

Conjugate Break-up

Break-up in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I break-up	We break-up
You break-up	You break-up
He/She/It breaks-up	They break-up

Break-up in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am breaking-up	We are breaking-up
You are breaking-up	You are breaking-up
He/She/It is breaking-up	They are breaking-up

Break-up in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have broken-up	We have broken-up
You have broken-up	You have broken-up
He/She/It has broken-up	They have broken-up

Break-up in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been breaking-up	We have been breaking-up
You have been breaking-up	You have been breaking-up
He/She/It has been breaking-up	They have been breaking-up

Break-up in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I broke-up	We broke-up
You broke-up	You broke-up
He/She/It broke-up	They broke-up

Break-up in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was breaking-up	We were breaking-up
You were breaking-up	You were breaking-up
He/She/It was breaking-up	They were breaking-up

Break-up in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had broken-up	We had broken-up
You had broken-up	You had broken-up
He/She/It had broken-up	They had broken-up

Break-up in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been breaking-up	We had been breaking-up
You had been breaking-up	You had been breaking-up
He/She/It had been breaking-up	They had been breaking-up

Break-up in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will break-up	We will break-up
You will break-up	You will break-up
He/She/It will break-up	They will break-up

Break-up in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be breaking-up	We will be breaking-up
You will be breaking-up	You will be breaking-up
He/She/It will be breaking-up	They will be breaking-up

Singular	Plural
I will have been breaking-up	We will have been breaking-up
You will have been breaking-up	You will have been breaking-up
He/She/It will have been breaking-up	They will have been breaking-up
