Synonyms of "Breakneck" as an adjective (6 Words)

dangerously fast Involving or causing danger or risk; liable to hurt or harm.

flat out Lowered in pitch by one chromatic semitone.

high-speed Operating at high speed.

[lightning](#) Very quick.
*Galloping across the country at **lightning** speed.*

[rapid](#) Characterized by speed; moving with or capable of moving with high speed.
*A **rapid** rise through the ranks.*

[speedy](#) Done or occurring quickly.
*A **speedy** recovery.*

Usage Examples of "Breakneck" as an adjective

- *He drove at breakneck speed.*
- *A breakneck pace.*
