Associations of "Brightest" (30 Words)

bask	Revel in and make the most of (something pleasing). <i>The seals came ashore to breed and to bask.</i>
beam	Express with a beaming face or smile. <i>The detector simply pinpoints the radar beams that other ships transmit.</i>
brighten	Become clear. <i>Daffodils brighten up many gardens and parks.</i>
brightly	In a cheerful and lively way. <i>Chattering brightly.</i>
brightness	The quality or state of giving out or reflecting light. <i>There s so much light and brightness in their faces.</i>
brilliance	Intense brightness of light. <i>The nights were dark lit only by the brilliance of Aegean stars.</i>
brilliantly	With brightness. <i>At night the town was brilliantly lit.</i>
dazzling	Extremely impressive, beautiful, or skilful. <i>Dazzling snow.</i>
flash	A newsflash. <i>She glared at him her eyes flashing.</i>
glimmer	A flash of light (especially reflected light). <i>The moonlight glimmered on the lawn.</i>
glisten	The quality of shining with a bright reflected light. <i>His cheeks glistened with tears.</i>
glitter	Tiny pieces of sparkling material used for decoration. <i>The grass glittered with dew.</i>
glow	The amount of electromagnetic radiation leaving or arriving at a point on a surface. <i>He was glowing with health.</i>

illuminate	Decorate (a building or structure) with lights for a special occasion. <i>This is a carefully written large format manuscript illuminated by Leonardo Bellini.</i>
illumine	Light up; brighten. <i>He moved her lamp so that her face was illuminated.</i>
light	The light falling on the windows of a house. Light or lite beer.
limelight	A focus of public attention. <i>He enjoyed being in the limelight.</i>
lucent	Glowing with or giving off light. <i>The lucent moon.</i>
luminescent	Emitting light not caused by heat. <i>The team is developing a transparent luminescent solar concentrator.</i>
luminosity	The rate of emission of radiation, visible or otherwise. <i>Acrylic colours retain freshness and luminosity.</i>
luminous	Relating to light as it is perceived by the eye, rather than in terms of its actual energy. <i>A luminous glow.</i>
opalescence	The visual property of something having a milky brightness and a play of colors from the surface.
phosphorescent	Emitting light without appreciable heat as by slow oxidation of phosphorous. <i>The phosphorescent glow of decaying wood.</i>
polished	Refined, sophisticated, or elegant. <i>His polished prose.</i>
radiance	An attractive combination of good health and happiness. <i>The radiance of the sunset dwindled and died.</i>
radiant	A radiant point. <i>A bird with radiant green and red plumage.</i>
shine	Make a surface shine. <i>Tonight he will have a chance to shine and win a world boxing title.</i>
shining	Giving out or reflecting bright light. <i>He has set a shining example with his model behaviour.</i>
sunlight	The rays of the sun. <i>A shaft of sunlight.</i>
twinkle	(of a person's feet) move lightly and rapidly. <i>There s a perpetual twinkle in his eyes.</i>
