<a href="#">bask</a>	Revel in and make the most of (something pleasing). <i>The seals came ashore to breed and to <b>bask</b>.</i>
<a href="#">beam</a>	Express with a beaming face or smile. <i>The detector simply pinpoints the radar <b>beams</b> that other ships transmit.</i>
<a href="#">brighten</a>	Become clear. <i>Daffodils <b>brighten</b> up many gardens and parks.</i>
<b>brightly</b>	In a cheerful and lively way. <i>Chattering <b>brightly</b>.</i>
<a href="#">brightness</a>	The quality or state of giving out or reflecting light. <i>There s so much light and <b>brightness</b> in their faces.</i>
<b>brilliance</b>	Intense brightness of light. <i>The nights were dark lit only by the <b>brilliance</b> of Aegean stars.</i>
<b>brilliantly</b>	With brightness. <i>At night the town was <b>brilliantly</b> lit.</i>
<a href="#">dazzling</a>	Extremely impressive, beautiful, or skilful. <i><b>Dazzling</b> snow.</i>
<b>flash</b>	A newsflash. <i>She glared at him her eyes <b>flashing</b>.</i>
<b>glimmer</b>	A flash of light (especially reflected light). <i>The moonlight <b>glimmered</b> on the lawn.</i>
<b>glisten</b>	The quality of shining with a bright reflected light. <i>His cheeks <b>glistened</b> with tears.</i>
<a href="#">glitter</a>	Tiny pieces of sparkling material used for decoration. <i>The grass <b>glittered</b> with dew.</i>
<b>glow</b>	The amount of electromagnetic radiation leaving or arriving at a point on a surface. <i>He was <b>glowing</b> with health.</i>

<b>illuminate</b>	Decorate (a building or structure) with lights for a special occasion. <i>This is a carefully written large format manuscript <b>illuminated</b> by Leonardo Bellini.</i>
<b>illumine</b>	Light up; brighten. <i>He moved her lamp so that her face was <b>illuminated</b>.</i>
<b>light</b>	The light falling on the windows of a house. <b>Light</b> or lite beer.
<b>limelight</b>	A focus of public attention. <i>He enjoyed being in the <b>limelight</b>.</i>
<b>lucent</b>	Glowing with or giving off light. <i>The <b>lucent</b> moon.</i>
<b>luminescent</b>	Emitting light not caused by heat. <i>The team is developing a transparent <b>luminescent</b> solar concentrator.</i>
<b>luminosity</b>	The rate of emission of radiation, visible or otherwise. <i>Acrylic colours retain freshness and <b>luminosity</b>.</i>
<b>luminous</b>	Relating to light as it is perceived by the eye, rather than in terms of its actual energy. <i>A <b>luminous</b> glow.</i>
<b>opalescence</b>	The visual property of something having a milky brightness and a play of colors from the surface.
<b>phosphorescent</b>	Emitting light without appreciable heat as by slow oxidation of phosphorous. <i>The <b>phosphorescent</b> glow of decaying wood.</i>
<b>polished</b>	Refined, sophisticated, or elegant. <i>His <b>polished</b> prose.</i>
<b>radiance</b>	An attractive combination of good health and happiness. <i>The <b>radiance</b> of the sunset dwindled and died.</i>
<b>radiant</b>	A radiant point. <i>A bird with <b>radiant</b> green and red plumage.</i>
<b>shine</b>	Make a surface shine. <i>Tonight he will have a chance to <b>shine</b> and win a world boxing title.</i>
<b>shining</b>	Giving out or reflecting bright light. <i>He has set a <b>shining</b> example with his model behaviour.</i>
<b>sunlight</b>	The rays of the sun. <i>A shaft of <b>sunlight</b>.</i>
<b>twinkle</b>	(of a person's feet) move lightly and rapidly. <i>There s a perpetual <b>twinkle</b> in his eyes.</i>
