## Associations of "Bring down" (30 Words)

<u>curtail</u>	Reduce in extent or quantity; impose a restriction on. <i>Civil liberties were further curtailed</i> .
debase	Corrupt debase or make impure by adding a foreign or inferior substance often by replacing valuable ingredients with inferior ones. <i>The King was forced to <b>debase</b> the coinage.</i>
declension	A downward slope or bend. The <b>declension</b> of the new generation.
decline	Bend down; droop. The birth rate continued to <b>decline</b> .
declivity	A downward slope. A thickly wooded <b>declivity</b> .
decrease	The amount by which something decreases. The aisles were <b>decrease</b> d in height.
decrement	The amount by which something decreases. The dose was reduced by 10 mg weekly <b>decrement</b> s.
demoralize	Lower someone's spirits; make downhearted. The General Strike had <b>demoralize</b> d the trade unions.
<u>depletion</u>	Reduction in the number or quantity of something. The <b>depletion</b> of the ozone layer.
<u>depress</u>	Lower someone's spirits; make downhearted. The rising inflation <b>depress</b> ed the economy.
descend	Make a sudden attack on. The militia <b>descend</b> ed on Rye.
descending	Moving down a scale of quality. A passage of <b>descending</b> chords.
<u>descent</u>	Properties attributable to your ancestry. A steep badly eroded <b>descent</b> .



Decrease in size, extent, or range. The trial has aged and <b>diminish</b> ed him.
A downward gradient on a railway or road. Some jobs had gradually been <b>downgrade</b> d from skilled to semi skilled.
A worsening of business or economic activity. The market took a <b>downturn</b> .
Towards a lower place, point, or level. The <b>downward</b> pull of gravity.
An act of dropping supplies or troops by parachute. The light <b>drop</b> ped from the ceiling.
A controlled act of falling especially as a stunt or in martial arts. <i>Fall</i> into a strange way of thinking.
Moving from a higher to a lower level, typically rapidly and without control. <i>Falling</i> standards.
Wear off or die down. The warmth of the afternoon <b>lessen</b> ed.
Of a vowel pronounced with the tongue held low in the mouth open. <i>His popularity ratings are at an all time low.</i>
Set lower. Land of a <b>lower</b> quality.
Reduce in size reduce physically. She has been <b>reduce</b> d to near poverty.
The action of remedying a dislocation or fracture by returning the affected part of the body to its normal position. We must see if the fracture requires <b>reduction</b> .
A concluding summary (as in presenting a case before a law court. A <b>rundown</b> in the business would be a devastating blow to the local economy.
Fall or sink heavily. They agreed to <b>sink</b> their differences.
The process or state of being submerged in or covered with water. Total <b>submergence</b> of plants results in heavy crop losses.
A material which provides the surface on which something is deposited or inscribed, for example the silicon wafer used to manufacture integrated circuits. <i>Optical disk substrates.</i>
