## Associations of "Bring forth" (30 Words)

<a href="#">ambush</a>	Hunt quarry by stalking and ambushing. <i>Tory representatives were <b>ambushed</b> by camera crews.</i>
<a href="#">apart</a>	To or on one side; at a distance from the main body. <i>He leapt out of the car just before it was blown <b>apart</b>.</i>
<a href="#">backlash</a>	A strong negative reaction by a large number of people, especially to a social or political development. <i>A public <b>backlash</b> against racism.</i>
<b>bounce</b>	Hit something so that it bounces. <i>The car <b>bounced</b> down the narrow track.</i>
<b>broach</b>	A decorative pin worn by women. <i>He <b>broached</b> the subject he had been avoiding all evening.</i>
<b>bullock</b>	A male domestic bovine animal that has been castrated and is raised for beef. <i>People have dropped dead <b>bullocking</b> their guts out.</i>
<a href="#">bumpy</a>	(of a surface) uneven, with many patches raised above the rest. <i>The <b>bumpy</b> flight brought on a bout of airsickness.</i>
<b>cart</b>	Transport something in a cart. <i>Their push<b>cart</b> was piled high with groceries.</i>
<a href="#">distant</a>	Remote or far apart in resemblance or relationship. <i>I remember that <b>distant</b> afternoon.</i>
<a href="#">far</a>	Being the animal or vehicle on the right or being on the right side of an animal or vehicle. <i>The <b>far</b> right.</i>
<b>faraway</b>	Very far away in space or time. <i>She had a <b>faraway</b> look in her eyes.</i>
<b>fetch</b>	The action of fetching. <i>Kind offers <b>fetched</b> tears from me.</i>

<b>further</b>	In addition or furthermore. <i>This theme will be developed <b>further</b> in Chapter 6.</i>
<b>haul</b>	The act of drawing or hauling something. <i>He made a living <b>hauling</b> coal.</i>
<b>hop</b>	A hopping movement. <i>The society's regular fortnightly <b>hop</b>.</i>
<b>inaccessible</b>	Capable of being reached only with great difficulty or not at all. <i>The city centre is <b>inaccessible</b> to traffic in most places.</i>
<b>jump</b>	Jump from an airplane and descend with a parachute. <i>They <b>jumped</b> back into the car and drove off.</i>
<b>leap</b>	Cause to jump or leap. <i>The child <b>leapt</b> across the puddle.</i>
<b>outside</b>	On the outside. <i>Disdaining <b>outside</b> pressure groups.</i>
<b>ox</b>	Used in names of wild animals related to or resembling a domesticated ox e.g musk ox. <i>An <b>ox</b> cart.</i>
<b>pounce</b>	The act of pouncing. <i>The gang <b>pounced</b> on him and knocked him to the ground.</i>
<b>rebound</b>	The act of securing possession of the rebounding basketball after a missed shot. <i>He proved that he can score and <b>rebound</b> as well as any of his peers.</i>
<b>recoil</b>	The action of recoiling. <i>If man upsets his planetary ecosystem it will automatically <b>recoil</b> upon him.</i>
<b>remote</b>	A remote control device. <i><b>Remote</b> stars.</i>
<b>resurface</b>	Arise or become evident again. <i>I helped my mother to <b>resurface</b> the kitchen floor.</i>
<b>separately</b>	Apart from others. <i>I shall consider that figure <b>separately</b> from the prime costs.</i>
<b>skip</b>	A light bouncing step a skipping movement. <i>She began to <b>skip</b> down the path.</i>
<b>spring</b>	Spring back spring away from an impact. <i>The president sought to <b>spring</b> the hostages.</i>
<b>tumbrel</b>	A farm dumpcart for carrying dung; carts of this type were used to carry prisoners to the guillotine during the French Revolution.
