cart	Convey or put in a cart or similar vehicle. They were <b>cart</b> ed off to the nearest police station.
drag	A hunt using a drag lure. Taxation is a <b>drag</b> on the economy.
except	Take exception to. <i>Five classes of advertisement are</i> <b>except</b> ed from control.



exclude	Remove from consideration. <i>This policy</i> <b>exclude</b> <i>s people who have a criminal record from entering the country.</i>
<u>exhale</u>	Give out (breath or an odor. She sat back and <b>exhale</b> d deeply.
get	Take vengeance on or get even. Her childish behavior really <b>get</b> to me.
<u>haul</u>	The act of drawing or hauling something. They escaped with a <b>haul</b> of antiques.
home	At or to or in the direction of one s home or family. <i>He grew up in a good Christian home.</i>
instead	On the contrary. Used English terms <b>instead</b> of Latin ones.
leave	Leave behind unintentionally. 19 minus 8 <b>leave</b> s 11.
mail	Email. You ve got <b>mail</b> .
mailing	The transmission of a letter. The candidate sent out three large <b>mailing</b> s.
<u>omit</u>	Fail or neglect to do. <i>He was <b>omit</b>ted from the second Test.</i>
recipient	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. <i>The recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize.</i>
<u>redefine</u>	Give a new or different definition of (a word. She <b>redefine</b> d his duties.
<u>residence</u>	The official house or establishment of an important person (as a sovereign or president. <i>She took up residence in Paris.</i>
respire	Recover hope, courage, or strength after a time of difficulty. A country where fresh air seems impossible to <b>respire</b> .
sender	A person who sends or transmits a message, letter, email, etc. <i>Return to sender.</i>
tumbrel	A farm dumpcart for carrying dung; carts of this type were used to carry prisoners to the guillotine during the French Revolution.
