recipient	Receiving or capable of receiving something. A <b>recipient</b> country.
<u>redefine</u>	Give a new or different definition of (a word. The role of the Emperor was <b>redefine</b> d.
residence	A large and imposing house. She took up <b>residence</b> in Paris.
respire	(of a plant) carry out respiration, especially at night when photosynthesis has ceased. A country where fresh air seems impossible to <b>respire</b> .
sender	A person who sends or transmits a message, letter, email, etc. <i>Return to <b>sender</b>.</i>
tumbrel	A farm dumpcart for carrying dung; carts of this type were used to carry prisoners to the guillotine during the French Revolution.
