<u>aggrandize</u>	Add details to. He hoped to <b>aggrandize</b> himself by dying a hero s death.
<u>amplify</u>	Make multiple copies of (a gene or DNA sequence. <i>The manufacturers have developed a system of</i> <b>amplify</b> ing the radio signal.
<u>bloat</u>	Make bloated or swollen. The dead man s stomach was <b>bloat</b> ed.
broad	Broad in scope or content T G Winner. The valley is three miles long and half a mile <b>broad</b> .
<u>diffuse</u>	Spread or diffuse through. Gas is <b>diffuse</b> d into the bladder.
dilate	Add details, as to an account or idea; clarify the meaning of and discourse in a learned way, usually in writing. <i>Her eyes <b>dilate</b>d with horror</i> .
distend	Cause to expand as it by internal pressure. <i>Air is introduced into the stomach to <b>distend</b> it.</i>
diversify	Vary in order to spread risk or to expand. New plants will <b>diversify</b> the habitat.
elongate	Long in relation to width elongated. An <b>elongate</b> tail tapering to a point.
<u>enlarge</u>	Add details, as to an account or idea; clarify the meaning of and discourse in a learned way, usually in writing. <i>She enlarge</i> d the flower beds.
escalation	An increase to counteract a perceived discrepancy. Higher wages caused an <b>escalation</b> of prices.
expand	Expand the influence of. Their business <b>expand</b> ed into other hotels.



expansion	A discussion that provides additional information. The rapid <b>expansion</b> of suburban London.
exponentially	By means of or as expressed by a mathematical exponent. Values distributed <b>exponentially</b> according to a given time constant.
<u>extend</u>	Thrust or extend out. The law was <b>extend</b> ed to all citizens.
growing	The process of an individual organism growing organically a purely biological unfolding of events involved in an organism changing gradually from a simple to a more complex level. <i>The growing concern over ozone levels.</i>
lengthen	Make longer. In the spring when the days are <b>lengthen</b> ing.
magnification	A magnified reproduction of something
<u>magnify</u>	Increase in size, volume or significance. Praise the Lord and <b>magnify</b> Him.
pervasiveness	The quality of spreading widely or being present throughout an area or a group of people. The <b>pervasiveness</b> of violence on television.
proliferate	Grow rapidly. Cultured cells often <b>proliferate</b> indefinitely.
prolongation	Extension of the duration of something. An agreement on further <b>prolongation</b> of the boundary proved difficult.
<u>propagate</u>	Cause to propagate as by grafting or layering. The French <b>propagate</b> d the idea that the English were drunkards.
protract	Prolong. He had certainly taken his time even <b>protract</b> ing the process.
spread	The fact or process of spreading over an area. The <b>spread</b> of the urban population into rural areas.
stretch	A stretch limo. There were <b>stretch</b> es of boredom.
stretching	Act of expanding by lengthening or widening.
swell	Excellently; very well. She felt herself <b>swell</b> with pride.
<u>unfold</u>	Extend or stretch out to a greater or the full length. He <b>unfold</b> ed the map and laid it out on the table.



widen Become broader or wider or more extensive. *The road widened.*
