
• Fasten with or as if with a brooch.

earring Jewelry to ornament the ear; usually clipped to the earlobe or fastened through

a hole in the lobe.

Decorate with or as with gems.

Tiny drops of sweat **gem**med his forehead.

Having the deep slightly brownish color of gold.

She has a heart of **gold**.

hang Deliver a pitch which does not change direction and is easily hit by a batter.

This worry **hang**s on my mind.

A hard typically green stone used for ornaments and implements and

jade consisting of the minerals jadeite or nephrite.

A **jade** figurine.

An adornment (as a bracelet or ring or necklace) made of precious metals and

set with gems (or imitation gems.

medallion An award for winning a championship or commemorating some other event.
