- breastpin** A small brooch or badge worn on the chest, typically to fasten a garment.
- broach** A decorative pin worn by women.
- clasp** A device with interlocking parts used for fastening things together.
*We embraced a tight **clasp** with cheeks touching.*
- clip** The act of clipping or snipping.
*A gilt **clip** fastened her hair.*
- fastening** The act of fastening things together.
*A fly front **fastening**.*
- pin** A piece of jewelry that is pinned onto the wearer's garment.
*A gold and diamond lapel **pin**.*

definitions:

- *Fasten with or as if with a brooch.*



Synonyms of "Brooch" as a verb (1 Word)

clasp Hold firmly and tightly.
*One modest emerald **clasped** her robe.*

- amber** A honey yellow colour typical of amber.
*Her eyes were green flecked with **amber**.*
- amethyst** A violet or purple colour.
***Amethyst** earrings.*
- badge** Put a badge on.
*They wore plastic name **badges**.*
- bauble** A mock scepter carried by a court jester.
*Once stripped of their tinsel and **baubles** most Christmas trees end up in landfill.*

bead	An ornamental plaster moulding resembling a string of beads or having a semicircular cross section. <i>Bead the wedding gown.</i>
beaded	Covered with beads of liquid. <i>A face beaded with sweat.</i>
bracelet	Jewelry worn around the wrist for decoration.
chandelier	Branched lighting fixture; often ornate; hangs from the ceiling.
circlet	A small circular arrangement or object.
dangle	Cause to dangle or hang freely. <i>Saucepans dangled from a rail.</i>
decorative	Relating to decoration. <i>A decorative artist.</i>
diamond	A tool with a small diamond for cutting glass. <i>A sweater with a pale blue diamond pattern.</i>
earring	Jewelry to ornament the ear; usually clipped to the earlobe or fastened through a hole in the lobe.
gem	Decorate with or as with gems. <i>Tiny drops of sweat gemmed his forehead.</i>
gold	Having the deep slightly brownish color of gold. <i>She has a heart of gold.</i>
hang	Deliver a pitch which does not change direction and is easily hit by a batter. <i>This worry hangs on my mind.</i>
jade	A hard typically green stone used for ornaments and implements and consisting of the minerals jadeite or nephrite. <i>A jade figurine.</i>
jewelry	An adornment (as a bracelet or ring or necklace) made of precious metals and set with gems (or imitation gems).
medallion	An award for winning a championship or commemorating some other event. <i>Medallions of veal.</i>
nacre	Mother-of-pearl.
necklace	In South Africa kill someone with a tyre necklace. <i>A diamond necklace.</i>
ornament	Make more attractive by adding ornament colour etc. <i>Tables covered with ornaments and books.</i>
ornate	Elaborately or highly decorated. <i>An ornate wrought iron railing.</i>

- pearl** Something resembling a pearl.
*The peaked hills were blue and **pearled** with clouds.*
- pendant** A necklace with a pendant.
*A **pendant** bunch of grapes.*
- pin** Pierce with a pin.
*A gold and diamond lapel **pin**.*
- ring** Make bells ring often for the purposes of musical edification.
*The distinctive **ring** of the church bell.*
- sidewalk** Walk consisting of a paved area for pedestrians; usually beside a street or roadway.
- trinket** Cheap showy jewelry or ornament on clothing.
- turquoise** A shade of blue tinged with green.
*Blue **turquoise** is valued as a gemstone.*
