<u>elicit</u>	Call forth (emotions, feelings, and responses. The work elicit ed enormous public interest.
<u>engage</u>	Engage or hire for work. She had offered to engage a room in the house of the woman.
<u>entail</u>	A property bequeathed under an entail. <i>Her father s estate was entailed on a cousin.</i>
extort	Obtain through intimidation. He attempted to extort money from the company.



extract	Extract by the process of distillation. The table is extract ed from the report.
fetch	The action of fetching. The old print fetch ed a high price at the auction.
get	Take vengeance on or get even. Did you get it.
gravitational	Denoting a forceful attraction or movement towards something. For many international companies Russia s gravitational pull is simply too strong to resist.
handled	Having a usually specified type of handle. A two handled cup.
<u>haul</u>	The act of drawing or hauling something. The thirty mile haul to Boston.
have	Have sex with archaic use. <i>How many cars does she have</i> .
impose	Impose and collect. The director was unable to impose himself on the production.
<u>lend</u>	Bestow a quality on. Stewart asked me to lend him my car.
OX	Used in names of wild animals related to or resembling a domesticated ox e g musk ox. Laden wagons pulled by lowing o xen travel down to the coast.
pull	Cause to move by pulling. <i>Pull a horse.</i>
take	Of a plant or seed take root or begin to grow germinate. We take the Times every day.
tow	A rope or line used to tow a vehicle or boat. A pickup van tow ing a trailer.
<u>trail</u>	A trailer for a film or broadcast. A recent television trail for The Bill.
<u>truck</u>	Convey by truck. Private contractors were truck ing for Denali.
tumbrel	A farm dumpcart for carrying dung; carts of this type were used to carry prisoners to the guillotine during the French Revolution.
wreak	Cause to happen or to occur as a consequence. They would soon have a chance to wreak their revenge on the enemy.
