adobe	A brick formed from adobe. <i>Adobe houses.</i>
based	Having a base of operations (often used as a combining form). <i>Firmly based ice.</i>
brick	Throw bricks at. <i>Installing an unofficial OS voids the warranty and may brick the phone.</i>
cement	Make fast as if with cement. <i>They stood on the grey cement beside the pool.</i>
concoct	Make a concoction of by mixing. <i>His cronies concocted a simple plan.</i>
concrete	Cover an area with concrete. <i>The precious English countryside may soon be concreted over.</i>
construct	Make by combining materials and parts. <i>Poetics should construct a theory of literary discourse.</i>
create	Create by artistic means. <i>Over 170 jobs were created.</i>
delicatessen	A shop selling ready-to-eat food products.
edifice	A structure that has a roof and walls and stands more or less permanently in one place. <i>The concepts on which the edifice of capitalism was built.</i>
establish	Build or establish something abstract. <i>The two countries established diplomatic relations in 1992.</i>
fabricate	Make up something artificial or untrue. <i>You will have to fabricate an exhaust system.</i>
fancied	Formed or conceived by the imagination. <i>A fancied wrong.</i>

floor	The occupants of a floor. <i>The ocean floor.</i>
forge	A workplace where metal is worked by heating and hammering. <i>He forged ahead.</i>
formulate	Prepare according to a formula. <i>Use special effects paints that are formulated for the task.</i>
found	Set up or found. <i>Collages of found photos.</i>
foundation	An institution established with an endowment, for example a research body or charity. <i>Build the arch resting on top of this solid foundation.</i>
institute	An association organized to promote art or science or education. <i>The award was instituted in 1900.</i>
invent	Come up with (an idea, plan, explanation, theory, or principle) after a mental effort. <i>He invented an improved form of the steam engine.</i>
kiln	A furnace for firing or burning or drying such things as porcelain or bricks.
make	Make by shaping or bringing together constituents. <i>Make enemies.</i>
manufacture	Manufactured articles. <i>The porcelain manufacture for which France became justly renowned.</i>
muralist	A painter of murals.
parapet	A low wall along the edge of a roof or balcony. <i>The sandbags that made up the parapet had been blown away and the wall of the trench had caved in.</i>
reclaim	The action or process of reclaiming or being reclaimed. <i>A sufficient weight of plastic could easily be reclaimed.</i>
roof	Provide a building with a roof cover a building with a roof. <i>They slept under the same roof.</i>
ruse	An action intended to deceive someone; a trick. <i>Emma tried to think of a ruse to get Paul out of the house.</i>
thatch	Cover with thatch. <i>They have constructed the walls and are now thatching the roof.</i>
tile	Cover with tiles. <i>Tile the wall and the floor of the bathroom.</i>
