- *Someone who contracts for and supervises construction (as of a building).*
- *A substance added to soaps or detergents to increase their cleansing action.*
- *A person who constructs something by putting parts or material together.*
- *A person or thing that creates or develops a particular thing.*



Synonyms of "Builder" as a noun (17 Words)

architect

A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.

*The **architects** of the reform programme.*

bricklayer

A craftsman skilled in building with bricks.

construction worker

A thing constructed; a complex entity constructed of many parts.

constructor

Someone who contracts for and supervises construction (as of a building).

*The country's biggest **constructor** of naval vessels.*

contriver

A person who makes plans.

craftsman

A professional whose work is consistently of high quality.

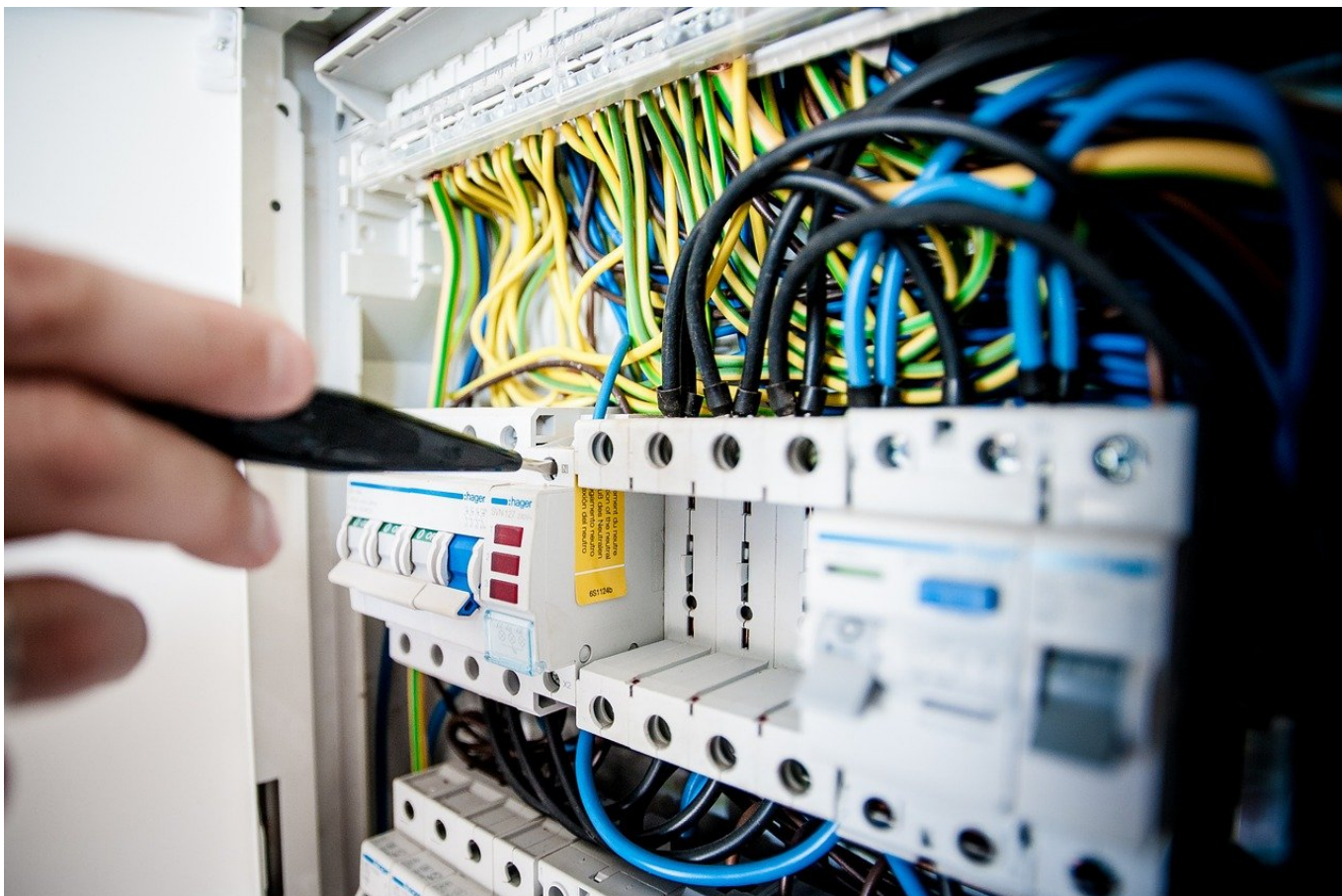
*As an actor he was a consummate **craftsman**.*

creator

Used as a name for God.

*Water the **creator** of climate and weather.*

<u>designer</u>	A person who specializes in designing architectural interiors and their furnishings. <i>He s one of the world s leading car designers.</i>
detergent builder	A surface-active chemical widely used in industry and laundering.
developer	A person who grows or matures at a specified time or rate. <i>A property developer.</i>
deviser	A gift of real property by will.
fabricator	Someone who tells lies.
ganger	The foreman of a work gang.
labourer	Someone who works with their hands; someone engaged in manual labor. <i>A farm labourer.</i>
maker	A person who makes things. <i>Film makers.</i>
planner	A person who controls or plans urban development. <i>Economic planners.</i>
producer	A person, company, or country that makes, grows, or supplies goods or commodities for sale. <i>A film producer.</i>

- architecture** The discipline dealing with the principles of design and construction and ornamentation of fine buildings.

- blacksmith** A farrier.
- blueprint** Make a blueprint of.
*They are redrawing office **blueprints** to include large shared spaces.*

bricklayer	A person whose job is to build walls, houses, and other structures with bricks.
<u>carpenter</u>	Do the work of a carpenter. <i>She carpenters and goes on archaeological digs.</i>
carpentry	The work made or done by a carpenter. <i>Carpentry skills.</i>
contractor	A person or firm that undertakes a contract to provide materials or labour to perform a service or do a job. <i>Building contractors.</i>
<u>craftsman</u>	A skilled worker who practices some trade or handicraft. <i>As an actor he was a consummate craftsman.</i>
electrician	A person who installs or repairs electrical or telephone lines.
<u>engineer</u>	Design as an engineer. <i>The prime engineer of the approach.</i>
engraver	A person who cuts or carves text or designs on the surface of hard objects. <i>The engraver etches the design into a high quality steel plate.</i>
glazier	Someone who cuts flat glass to size.
mason	A Freemason. <i>One course of massive stones roughly masoned.</i>
<u>mechanic</u>	Resembling the action of a machine. <i>A car mechanic.</i>
modernist	An artist who makes a deliberate break with previous styles. <i>His early work explored all manner of modernist styles.</i>
painter	A worker who is employed to cover objects with paint. <i>A self employed painter and decorator.</i>
plumber	A person who fits and repairs the pipes, fittings, and other apparatus of water supply, sanitation, or heating systems.
redesign	The action or process of redesigning something. <i>The front seats have been redesigned.</i>
remodel	Cast or model anew. <i>The station was remodelled and enlarged in 1927.</i>
sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures.
silversmith	A person who makes silver articles.
smith	A worker in metal. <i>Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being smithed into bracelets.</i>

- spire** The continuation of a tree trunk above the point where branching begins, especially in a tree of a tapering form.
Spires of delphiniums.
- tanner** A person who is employed to tan animal hides.
Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless tanners.
- woodwork** The activity or skill of making things from wood.
*Derby twice hit the **woodwork**.*
- workshop** A meeting at which a group of people engage in intensive discussion and activity on a particular subject or project.
*A writers **workshop** was held on 25 27 July.*
- wright** United States aviation pioneer who (with his brother Orville Wright) invented the airplane (1867-1912).
