<a href="#">bar</a>	The crossbar of a goal. <i>Journalists had been <b>barred</b> from covering the elections.</i>
<b>barricade</b>	Block off with barricades. <i><b>Barricade</b> the streets.</i>
<b>barrier</b>	A circumstance or obstacle that keeps people or things apart or prevents communication or progress. <i>The mountain <b>barrier</b> between Norway and Sweden.</i>
<a href="#">closure</a>	Apply the closure to a debate or speaker in a legislative assembly. <i>He brings modernistic <b>closure</b> to his narrative.</i>
<b>construction</b>	The industry of constructing buildings, roads, etc. <i>50 000 more jobs will go from <b>construction</b>.</i>
<b>contraband</b>	Goods that have been imported or exported illegally. <i><b>Contraband</b> brandy.</i>
<b>cube</b>	Cut food into small cubes. <i>I bought sirloin from the butcher and <b>cubed</b> it myself.</i>
<b>cubic</b>	A cubic equation or a curve described by one. <i>A <b>cubic</b> room.</i>
<b>dice</b>	A game played with dice. <i>His side continue to <b>dice</b> with disaster.</i>
<b>difficulty</b>	The quality of being difficult. <i>There is a practical <b>difficulty</b>.</i>
<a href="#">disallow</a>	Command against. <i>He was offside and the goal was <b>disallowed</b>.</i>
<a href="#">discouraged</a>	Having lost confidence or enthusiasm; disheartened. <i>The accident left others <b>discouraged</b> about going there.</i>
<a href="#">fence</a>	Surround or protect with a fence. <i>Walkers may find themselves <b>fenced</b> out of the moor.</i>

<b><u>forbid</u></b>	(of a circumstance or quality) make (something) impossible; prevent. <i>All vehicles are <b>forbidden</b>.</i>
<b>interdict</b>	A court order prohibiting a party from doing a certain activity. <i>I have not been <b>interdicted</b> from consuming alcoholic beverages.</i>
<b>interdiction</b>	A court order prohibiting a party from doing a certain activity. <i>The <b>interdiction</b> of the slave trade.</i>
<b>lattice</b>	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. <i>The <b>lattice</b> of branches above her.</i>
<b>levee</b>	A ridge of sediment deposited naturally alongside a river by overflowing water.
<b><u>pessimistic</u></b>	Tending to see the worst aspect of things or believe that the worst will happen. <i>He was <b>pessimistic</b> about the prospects.</i>
<b><u>prohibit</u></b>	Formally forbid (something) by law, rule, or other authority. <i>He is <b>prohibited</b> from becoming a director.</i>
<b>prohibitionist</b>	A reformer who opposes the use of intoxicating beverages.
<b>prohibitory</b>	Tending to discourage (especially of prices).
<b>proscribe</b>	Denounce or condemn. <i>A plaque on which were the names of <b>proscribed</b> traitors.</i>
<b>rampart</b>	Fortify or surround with or as if with a rampart. <i>A castle with <b>ramparts</b> and a moat.</i>
<b><u>scaffold</u></b>	Provide with a scaffold for support. <i><b>Scaffold</b> the building before painting it.</i>
<b><u>square</u></b>	Denoting the length of each side of a square shape or object. <i>A <b>square</b> deal.</i>
<b><u>stance</u></b>	A site on a street for a market, street vendor's stall, or taxi rank. <i>She altered her <b>stance</b> resting all her weight on one leg.</i>
<b>stanch</b>	Stop the flow of a liquid.
<b><u>wall</u></b>	Anything that suggests a wall in structure or function or effect. <i>A garden <b>wall</b>.</i>
