- (of a person) having a specified physical size or build.





### Synonyms of "Built" as an adjective (1 Word)

(used of soaps or cleaning agents) having a substance (an abrasive or filler) reinforced added to increase effectiveness. *Reinforced* concrete contains steel bars or metal netting.

adobe	A building constructed from adobe clay or bricks. <b>Adobe</b> houses.
based	Having a base of operations (often used as a combining form. <i>Carrier</i> <b>based</b> planes.
brick	Bricks collectively as a building material. A large <b>brick</b> building.
<u>cement</u>	Make fast as if with cement. Dental <b>cement</b> .
<u>concoct</u>	Make a concoction of by mixing. His cronies <b>concoct</b> ed a simple plan.
<u>concrete</u>	Fix in position with concrete. <i>The precious English countryside may soon be concreted over.</i>
construct	Draw with suitable instruments and under specified conditions. <i>Construct a paragraph</i> .



create	Create by artistic means. <b>Create</b> a poem.
delicatessen	A shop selling ready-to-eat food products.
edifice	A large, imposing building. The concepts on which the <b>edifice</b> of capitalism was built.
establish	Establish the validity of something as by an example explanation or experiment. The principle of the supremacy of national parliaments needs to be firmly <b>establish</b> ed.
fabricate	Construct or manufacture (an industrial product), especially from prepared components. <i>Officers fabricated evidence.</i>
fancied	Formed or conceived by the imagination. A <b>fancied</b> wrong.
<u>floor</u>	Provide a room or area with a floor. The best way to play is to pass the ball on the <b>floor</b> .
<u>forge</u>	Make or shape (a metal object) by heating it in a fire or furnace and hammering it. <i>He</i> <b>forge</b> <i>d</i> ahead.
<u>formulate</u>	Create or prepare methodically. The government has <b>formulate</b> d a policy on waste management.
found	Of art comprising or making use of found objects. The lost and <b>found</b> department.
foundation	An institution established with an endowment, for example a research body or charity. <i>Heavy foundations and concealers can contribute to dull skin and clogged</i> <i>pores.</i>
institute	Advance or set forth in court. The award was <b>institute</b> d in 1900.
<u>invent</u>	Concoct something artificial or untrue. He <b>invent</b> ed an improved form of the steam engine.
kiln	A furnace or oven for burning, baking, or drying, especially one for calcining lime or firing pottery.
make	Make by shaping or bringing together constituents. Can you <b>make</b> me an omelette.
manufacture	Manufactured articles. Firms who <b>manufacture</b> ball bearings.



muralist	A painter of murals.
parapet	A low wall along the edge of a roof or balcony. Mr Scargill raised his head above the <b>parapet</b> to call for the repeal of anti union legislation.
reclaim	The action or process of reclaiming or being reclaimed. <i>You can <b>reclaim</b> 25 of the 435 deducted.</i>
<u>roof</u>	Function as the roof of. The yard had been roughly <b>roof</b> ed over with corrugated iron.
<u>ruse</u>	An action intended to deceive someone; a trick. Emma tried to think of a <b>ruse</b> to get Paul out of the house.
thatch	Hair resembling thatched roofing material. A young man with a <b>thatch</b> of untidy blond hair.
tile	Cover with tiles. The lobby was <b>tile</b> d in blue.
