Associations of "Built up" (30 Words)

ascend	(of a voice or sound) rise in pitch. <i>The boat ascended the Delaware.</i>
ascending	Increasing in size or importance. <i>The ascending staircase.</i>
ascent	A climb or walk to the summit of a mountain or hill. <i>The ascent grew steeper.</i>
boost	Give a boost to be beneficial to. <i>A boost in exports.</i>
<u>climb</u>	An ascent especially of a mountain or hill by climbing. <i>How old will these graduates be before they begin a long climb out of debt.</i>
<u>climbing</u>	The sport or activity of climbing mountains or cliffs. <i>Climbing equipment.</i>
<u>elevate</u>	(of a priest) hold up (a consecrated host or chalice) for adoration. <i>The therapy can elevate serum amylase levels.</i>
elevator	The airfoil on the tailplane of an aircraft that makes it ascend or descend. <i>In the elevator she pressed the button for the lobby.</i>
escalator	A clause in a contract that provides for an increase or a decrease in wages or prices or benefits etc. depending on certain conditions (as a change in the cost of living index).
high	At a high price. <i>They stood on high and observed the countryside.</i>
<u>hoist</u>	An apparatus for lifting or raising something. <i>An interest rate hoist.</i>
ladder	With reference to tights or stockings develop or cause to develop a ladder. <i>The first time I put them on one of the stockings laddered.</i>
lift	An act of lifting. <i>Some actresses have more than one face lift.</i>

mounting	The action of mounting something. <i>The mounting of rapid fire guns.</i>
precipitate	A substance precipitated from a solution. <i>Excess moisture is precipitated as rain fog mist or dew.</i>
promote	Of an additive act as a promoter of a catalyst. <i>They were promoted from the Third Division last season.</i>
raise	Raise the level or amount of something. <i>The alarm was raised when he failed to return home.</i>
rise	Rise in rank or status. <i>The Euphrates rises in Turkey.</i>
risen	Above the horizon. <i>The risen sun.</i>
rising	Newly come into prominence. <i>A rising trend.</i>
soar	Fly a plane without an engine. <i>The gulls soared on the summery winds.</i>
soaring	Of imposing height; especially standing out above others. <i>Soaring prices.</i>
stairs	A flight of stairs or a flight of steps.
stepladder	A short folding ladder with flat steps and a small platform.
underpin	Support, justify, or form the basis for. <i>The theme of honour underpinning the two books.</i>
uphill	Against difficulties. <i>An uphill struggle to gain worldwide recognition.</i>
upstairs	The part of a building above the ground floor. <i>No one was allowed to see the upstairs.</i>
upward	Moving, pointing, or leading to a higher place, point, or level. <i>A general upward movement of fish.</i>
vertically	In a way that involves different levels or stages of a hierarchy or process. <i>The bacteria are vertically transmitted from mother to offspring.</i>
zoom	Cause a lens or camera to zoom in or out. <i>We watched the fly zooming around.</i>
