ascend	(of a voice or sound) rise in pitch. The boat <b>ascend</b> ed the Delaware.
ascending	Increasing in size or importance. The <b>ascending</b> staircase.
ascent	A climb or walk to the summit of a mountain or hill. <i>The <b>ascent</b> grew steeper.</i>
boost	Give a boost to be beneficial to. A <b>boost</b> in exports.
<u>climb</u>	An ascent especially of a mountain or hill by climbing. How old will these graduates be before they begin a long <b>climb</b> out of debt.
<u>climbing</u>	The sport or activity of climbing mountains or cliffs. <i>Climbing</i> equipment.
<u>elevate</u>	(of a priest) hold up (a consecrated host or chalice) for adoration. The therapy can <b>elevate</b> serum amylase levels.
elevator	The airfoil on the tailplane of an aircraft that makes it ascend or descend. In the <b>elevator</b> she pressed the button for the lobby.
escalator	A clause in a contract that provides for an increase or a decrease in wages or prices or benefits etc. depending on certain conditions (as a change in the cost of living index.
high	At a high price. They stood on <b>high</b> and observed the countryside.
<u>hoist</u>	An apparatus for lifting or raising something. An interest rate <b>hoist</b> .
ladder	With reference to tights or stockings develop or cause to develop a ladder. The first time I put them on one of the stockings <b>ladder</b> ed.
lift	An act of lifting. Some actresses have more than one face <b>lift</b> .



mounting	The action of mounting something. The <b>mounting</b> of rapid fire guns.
<u>precipitate</u>	A substance precipitated from a solution. Excess moisture is <b>precipitate</b> d as rain fog mist or dew.
promote	Of an additive act as a promoter of a catalyst. They were <b>promote</b> d from the Third Division last season.
raise	Raise the level or amount of something. The alarm was <b>raise</b> d when he failed to return home.
rise	Rise in rank or status. The Euphrates <b>rise</b> s in Turkey.
risen	Above the horizon. <i>The <b>risen</b> sun.</i>
rising	Newly come into prominence. A <b>rising</b> trend.
<u>soar</u>	Fly a plane without an engine. The gulls <b>soar</b> ed on the summery winds.
<u>soaring</u>	Of imposing height; especially standing out above others. <i>Soaring prices.</i>
stairs	A flight of stairs or a flight of steps.
stepladder	A short folding ladder with flat steps and a small platform.
<u>underpin</u>	Support, justify, or form the basis for. The theme of honour <b>underpin</b> ning the two books.
uphill	Against difficulties. An <b>uphill</b> struggle to gain worldwide recognition.
upstairs	The part of a building above the ground floor. No one was allowed to see the <b>upstairs</b> .
upward	Moving, pointing, or leading to a higher place, point, or level. A general <b>upward</b> movement of fish.
vertically	In a way that involves different levels or stages of a hierarchy or process. <i>The bacteria are vertically transmitted from mother to offspring.</i>
<u>zoom</u>	Cause a lens or camera to zoom in or out. We watched the fly <b>zoom</b> ing around.
