## Synonyms of "Bullseye" as a noun (11 Words)

### aim

An anticipated outcome that is intended or that guides your planned actions.  
*His **aim** was perfect.*

### **centre**

The middle player in a line or group in certain team games.  
*The **centre** of the ceiling.*

**dead centre** People who are no longer living.

### **focus**

The centre of interest or activity.  
*In **focus**.*

### **goal**

An instance of sending the ball into or over the goal especially as a unit of scoring in a game.  
*The decisive opening **goal**.*

**hub**

The effective centre of an activity, region, or network.  
*The kitchen was the **hub** of family life.*

**mark**

A marking that consists of lines that cross each other.  
*Some previous reader had covered the pages with dozens of **marks**.*

**mean**

An average of n numbers computed by adding some function of the numbers and dividing by some function of n.

**median**

The median value of a range of values.  
*Acreages ranged from one to fifty two with a **median** of twenty four.*

**midst**

The location of something surrounded by other things.  
*In the **midst** of the crowd.*

**nucleus**

The solid part of a comet's head.  
*The **nucleus** of a British film producing industry.*

- *A bullseye lantern.*
