- *A thick knob of glass at the centre of a blown glass sheet.*



## Synonyms of "Bullseye" as a noun (11 Words)

**aim**

An anticipated outcome that is intended or that guides your planned actions.  
*His **aim** was perfect.*

**centre**

The middle player in a line or group in certain team games.  
*The **centre** of the ceiling.*

**dead centre** People who are no longer living.

**focus**

The centre of interest or activity.  
*In **focus**.*

**goal**

An instance of sending the ball into or over the goal especially as a unit of scoring in a game.  
*The decisive opening **goal**.*

<b>hub</b>	The effective centre of an activity, region, or network. <i>The kitchen was the <b>hub</b> of family life.</i>
<b>mark</b>	A marking that consists of lines that cross each other. <i>Some previous reader had covered the pages with dozens of <b>marks</b>.</i>
<b>mean</b>	An average of n numbers computed by adding some function of the numbers and dividing by some function of n.
<b>median</b>	The median value of a range of values. <i>Acreages ranged from one to fifty two with a <b>median</b> of twenty four.</i>
<b>midst</b>	The location of something surrounded by other things. <i>In the <b>midst</b> of the crowd.</i>
<b>nucleus</b>	The solid part of a comet's head. <i>The <b>nucleus</b> of a British film producing industry.</i>
