fanfare	Media attention or elaborate ceremony. The studio released this film with great <b>fanfare</b> but no commercial success.



flourish	A display of ornamental speech or language. <i>She entered with a great <b>flourish</b>.</i>
flourishing	Very lively and profitable. A <b>flourishing</b> career.
grow	Cultivate by growing often involving improvements by means of agricultural techniques. Her hair doesn t <b>grow</b> much anymore.
growth	A tumour or other abnormal formation. A day s <b>growth</b> of unshaven stubble on his chin.
<u>inflation</u>	The action of inflating something or the condition of being inflated. <i>High <b>inflation</b> rates.</i>
metropolis	A large and densely populated urban area; may include several independent administrative districts. By the late eighteenth century Edo had grown to a <b>metropolis</b> with a population of nearly one million.
opulence	Wealth as evidenced by sumptuous living. <i>Rooms of spectacular <b>opulence</b></i> .
palmy	Covered with palms. A <b>palmy</b> time for stockbrokers.
prosper	Flourish physically; grow strong and healthy. The state hopes to <b>prosper</b> from free trade with the United States.
prosperous	Very lively and profitable. A <b>prosperous</b> moment to make a decision.
rich	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. A <b>rich</b> and famous family.
successful	Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status. Marketing of Japanese products has been highly <b>successful</b> .
teem	Be teeming be abuzz. Every garden is <b>teem</b> ing with wildlife.
<u>thrive</u>	Prosper; flourish. Education groups <b>thrive</b> on organization.
thriving	Very lively and profitable. A <b>thriving</b> tourist center.
well-to-do	Doctor's degree in osteopathy.
