<b>bonus</b>	An extra and unexpected advantage. <i>Good weather is an added <b>bonus</b> but the real appeal is the landscape.</i>
<a href="#">boom</a>	Make a loud, deep, resonant sound. <i>A dozen bitterns <b>boom</b> mysteriously from the reeds.</i>
<a href="#">booming</a>	Used of the voice. <i>A <b>booming</b> laugh.</i>
<b>daisy</b>	Used in names of other plants of the daisy family e g Michaelmas daisy Shasta daisy.
<b>ding</b>	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were <b>dinging</b> softly.</i>
<b>efflorescence</b>	The period of greatest prosperity or productivity. <i>Cover the brickwork to minimize <b>efflorescence</b>.</i>
<b>fanfare</b>	Media attention or elaborate ceremony. <i>The studio released this film with great <b>fanfare</b> but no commercial success.</i>

<b>flourish</b>	A display of ornamental speech or language. <i>She entered with a great <b>flourish</b>.</i>
<b>flourishing</b>	Very lively and profitable. <i>A <b>flourishing</b> career.</i>
<b>grow</b>	Cultivate by growing often involving improvements by means of agricultural techniques. <i>Her hair doesn't <b>grow</b> much anymore.</i>
<b>growth</b>	A tumour or other abnormal formation. <i>A day's <b>growth</b> of unshaven stubble on his chin.</i>
<b><u>inflation</u></b>	The action of inflating something or the condition of being inflated. <i>High <b>inflation</b> rates.</i>
<b>metropolis</b>	A large and densely populated urban area; may include several independent administrative districts. <i>By the late eighteenth century Edo had grown to a <b>metropolis</b> with a population of nearly one million.</i>
<b>opulence</b>	Wealth as evidenced by sumptuous living. <i>Rooms of spectacular <b>opulence</b>.</i>
<b>palmy</b>	Covered with palms. <i>A <b>palmy</b> time for stockbrokers.</i>
<b>prosper</b>	Flourish physically; grow strong and healthy. <i>The state hopes to <b>prosper</b> from free trade with the United States.</i>
<b>prosperous</b>	Very lively and profitable. <i>A <b>prosperous</b> moment to make a decision.</i>
<b>rich</b>	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. <i>A <b>rich</b> and famous family.</i>
<b>successful</b>	Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status. <i>Marketing of Japanese products has been highly <b>successful</b>.</i>
<b>teem</b>	Be teeming be abuzz. <i>Every garden is <b>teeming</b> with wildlife.</i>
<b><u>thrive</u></b>	Prosper; flourish. <i>Education groups <b>thrive</b> on organization.</i>
<b>thriving</b>	Very lively and profitable. <i>A <b>thriving</b> tourist center.</i>
<b>well-to-do</b>	Doctor's degree in osteopathy.
