Burgle in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am burgling We are burgling
You are burgling You are burgling
He/She/It is burgling They are burgling

Burgle in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have burgled We have burgled

You have burgled You have burgled

He/She/It has burgled They have burgled

Burgle in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been burgling We have been burgling

You have been burgling You have been burgling

He/She/It has been burgling They have been burgling

Burgle in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI burgledWe burgledYou burgledYou burgledHe/She/It burgledThey burgled

Burgle in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was burgling We were burgling
You were burgling You were burgling
He/She/It was burgling They were burgling

Burgle in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had burgled We had burgled
You had burgled You had burgled
He/She/It had burgled They had burgled

Burgle in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been burgling
You had been burgling
You had been burgling
He/She/It had been burgling They had been burgling

Burgle in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will burgle
You will burgle
He/She/It will burgle
They will burgle

Burgle in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be burgling
You will be burgling
He/She/It will be burgling
They will be burgling

Burgle in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have burgled We will have burgled
You will have burgled You will have burgled
He/She/It will have burgled They will have burgled

Burgle in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been burgling
You will have been burgling
You will have been burgling
He/She/It will have been burgling
They will have been burgling
